## **Encapsulates as a Verb**

### **Definitions of "Encapsulates" as a verb**

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “encapsulates” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Put in a short or concise form; reduce in volume.*
- *Enclose in a capsule or other small container.*



### Synonyms of "Encapsulates" as a verb (3 Words)

**capsule** Enclose in a capsule.

**capsulise** Put in a short or concise form; reduce in volume.

**capsulize** Put in a short or concise form; reduce in volume.  
*He was able to **capsulize** views on the referendum.*



## Associations of "Encapsulates" (30 Words)

- abbreviate** Reduce in scope while retaining essential elements.  
*Network is often **abbreviated** to net.*
- abbreviated** (of clothing) very short.  
*An **abbreviated** swimsuit.*
- abbreviation** The process of abbreviating something.  
*SKU is the **abbreviation** for Stock Keeping Unit.*
- abridge** Shorten (a piece of writing) without losing the sense.  
*The introduction is **abridged** from the author's afterword to the novel.*
- abridgment** A shortened version of a written work.
- bowdlerize** Edit by omitting or modifying parts considered indelicate.  
***Bowdlerize** a novel.*
- brief** Instruct a barrister by brief.  
*He cannot be too highly recommended if he is free and will take the **brief**.*

<b>briefly</b>	For a short time; fleetingly. <i><b>Briefly</b> we have a problem.</i>
<b>concisely</b>	In a concise manner; in a few words. <i>The history is summed up <b>concisely</b> in this book.</i>
<b>condensation</b>	(psychoanalysis) an unconscious process whereby two ideas or images combine into a single symbol; especially in dreams. <i>The inside of the cab steamed up with <b>condensation</b>.</i>
<b>contraction</b>	A shortening or tensing of a part or organ (especially of a muscle or muscle fiber). <i>Won't is a <b>contraction</b> of will not.</i>
<b>curtail</b>	Place restrictions on. <i><b>Curtail</b> drinking in school.</i>
<b>diminish</b>	Lessen the authority, dignity, or reputation of. <i>The trial has aged and <b>diminished</b> him.</i>
<b>elision</b>	The omission of a sound or syllable when speaking (as in I'm, let's). <i>The shortening of words by <b>elision</b>.</i>
<b>expurgate</b>	Remove matter thought to be objectionable or unsuitable from (a text or account). <i>Editors heavily <b>expurgated</b> the novel before its initial publication.</i>
<b>haircut</b>	An act of cutting a person's hair. <i>He's always very particular about his <b>haircut</b>.</i>
<b>minimize</b>	Represent as less significant or important. <i>They may <b>minimize</b> or even overlook the importance of such beliefs.</i>
<b>outline</b>	Draw up an outline or sketch for something. <i>The chalked <b>outline</b> of a human body.</i>
<b>precis</b>	Make a precis of a text or speech.
<b>profile</b>	Represent in profile by drawing or painting. <i>Skilfully made vessels with an S shaped <b>profile</b>.</i>
<b>reduce</b>	Reduce in size reduce physically. <i>He <b>reduced</b> his grandees to due obedience.</i>
<b>resume</b>	Take or put on again. <i><b>Resume</b> an office.</i>
<b>retrench</b>	Make a reduction, as in one's workforce. <i>Right wing parties which seek to <b>retrench</b> the welfare state.</i>
<b>short</b>	A short circuit. <i><b>Short</b> skirts.</i>

- shorten**      Make short or shorter.  
*In winter the days **shorten**.*
- shrink**      Become or make smaller in size or amount.  
*Can you **shrink** this image.*
- shrinkage**    The amount by which something shrinks.  
***Shrinkage** is the retail trade s euphemism for shoplifting.*
- summarize**    Give a summary (of).  
*The abstract **summarizes** the main ideas in the paper.*
- summary**      Performed speedily and without formality.  
*A **summary** of Chapter Three.*
- synopsis**      A brief summary or general survey of something.  
*A **synopsis** of the insurance cover provided is set out below.*
