ambient	Relating to ambient music. <i>The ambient air.</i>
assembler	A program for converting instructions written in low-level symbolic code into machine code.
besiege	Be inundated by large numbers of requests or complaints. <i>The television station was besieged with calls.</i>
bevy	A group of roe deer, quails, or larks. <i>A bevy of big name cameos will keep the adults entertained.</i>
correlate	Establish a mutual relationship or connection between. <i>Do these facts correlate.</i>
correlated	Mutually related.
cover	An area of the field consisting of cover point and extra cover. <i>Her new name and passport are cover for her next assignment.</i>
embedded	Enclosed firmly in a surrounding mass. <i>Confused by the embedded Latin quotations.</i>
encase	Enclose in, or as if in, a case. <i>My feet were encased in mud.</i>
encircle	Form or draw a circle around. <i>Encircle the errors.</i>
enclose	Enclose or enfold completely with or as if with a covering. <i>The entire estate was enclosed with walls.</i>
encompass	Surround and have or hold within. <i>An act designed to encompass the death of the king.</i>
envelop	Enclose or enfold completely with or as if with a covering. <i>A figure enveloped in a black cloak.</i>
environ	Surround; enclose. <i>The stone circle was environed by an expanse of peat soil.</i>

<u>implicated</u>	Culpably involved. <i>An innocent person implicated by circumstances in a crime.</i>
in	Batting. <i>Which side is in.</i>
include	Have as a part, be made up out of. <i>We must include this chemical element in the group.</i>
included	Enclosed in the same envelope or package. <i>Service tax included.</i>
<u>indirectly</u>	Not in a forthright manner. <i>The losses indirectly affect us all.</i>
<u>involve</u>	Occupy or engage the interest of. <i>The situation was rather involved.</i>
<u>involved</u>	Emotionally involved. <i>We accomplished nothing simply because of the large number of people involved.</i>
peristyle	A space such as a court or porch that is surrounded or edged by a peristyle.
<u>pertain</u>	Be relevant to. <i>My remark pertained to your earlier comments.</i>
<u>preoccupation</u>	The state or condition of being preoccupied or engrossed with something. <i>Their main preoccupation was how to feed their families.</i>
referent	Having reference. <i>Judgments referent to the indictment.</i>
subjectivity	The quality of being based on or influenced by personal feelings, tastes, or opinions. <i>In the writing of history there is a degree of subjectivity.</i>
<u>surround</u>	The area encircling something surroundings. <i>An oak fireplace surround.</i>
<u>surrounded</u>	Confined on all sides. <i>A camp surrounded by enemies.</i>
<u>trapped</u>	Forced to turn and face attackers. <i>Like a trapped animal.</i>
welder	A person who welds metal. <i>He worked as a welder in a steel factory.</i>
