<b>dynamic</b>	Of or relating to dynamics. <i>The <b>dynamic</b> president of the firm.</i>
<b>effective</b>	Able to accomplish a purpose functioning effectively. <i><b>Effective</b> steps toward peace.</i>
<b>effectual</b>	Producing or capable of producing an intended result or having a striking effect-LewisMumford. <i>His complaint proved to be <b>effectual</b> in bringing action.</i>
<b><u>emphatic</u></b>	Sudden and strong. <i>An <b>emphatic</b> no.</i>
<b>enthusiastic</b>	Having or showing great excitement and interest. <i>An <b>enthusiastic</b> response.</i>
<b>fiery</b>	Very intense. <i><b>Fiery</b> oratory.</i>
<b>forceful</b>	Forceful and definite in expression or action. <i>A <b>forceful</b> speaker.</i>
<b>frisky</b>	Playful and full of energy. <i>He bounds about like a <b>frisky</b> pup.</i>
