## Synonyms of "Engraved" as an adjective (4 Words)

### **etched**

Cut or impressed into a surface.  
**Etched** glass windows.

### **graven**

Cut or impressed into a surface.  
**Graven** images.

### **incised**

Sharply and deeply indented.  
An **incised** design.

(of loan stock) issued in the form of shares whose holders are listed in a register **inscribed** rather than issued with certificates.  
An **inscribed** watch.

## Associations of "Engraved" (30 Words)

- abbreviated** Cut short in duration.  
*The **abbreviated** speech.*
- abridge** Curtail (a right or privilege).  
*The new law might **abridge** our freedom of expression.*
- briefly** For a short time.  
*As I **briefly** mentioned earlier.*
- cartoon** Draw cartoons of.  
*We watched Yogi Bear **cartoons** on TV.*
- concisely** In a concise manner; in a few words.  
*The history is summed up **concisely** in this book.*
- concrete** Cover an area with concrete.  
*The precious English countryside may soon be **concreted** over.*

<b>contour</b>	Mark a map or diagram with contour lines. <i>It defines a major <b>contour</b> of this administration.</i>
<b>delineate</b>	Show the form or outline of. <i>His finger found a precisely outlined section <b>delineated</b> in red marker.</i>
<b>divergent</b>	Diverging from another or from a standard. <i><b>Divergent</b> interpretations.</i>
<b>doodle</b>	Make a doodle draw aimlessly. <i>The text was interspersed with <b>doodles</b>.</i>
<b>draft</b>	Select a player for a sports team through the draft. <i>A <b>draft</b> document.</i>
<b>draw</b>	The act of drawing or hauling something. <i>This chimney <b>draws</b> very well.</i>
<b>encapsulate</b>	Enclose in a capsule or other small container. <i>The company would <b>encapsulate</b> the asbestos waste in concrete pellets.</i>
<b>incised</b>	Cut into with a sharp instrument. <i>An <b>incised</b> design.</i>
<b>outline</b>	Draw up an outline or sketch for something. <i>An <b>outline</b> proposal.</i>
<b>plaque</b>	A sticky deposit on teeth in which bacteria proliferate. <i><b>Plaque</b> around gum margins can lead to gingivitis.</i>
<b>precis</b>	Make a precis of a text or speech.
<b>profile</b>	Represent in profile by drawing or painting. <i>In soft rocks a <b>profile</b> drawn normally to the beach would show a concave form comparable with the long <b>profile</b> of a river.</i>
<b>prospectus</b>	A printed booklet advertising a school or university to potential parents or students or giving details of a share offer for the benefit of investors. <i>A <b>prospectus</b> should contain the facts that an investor needs to make an informed decision.</i>
<b>recapitulate</b>	Summarize briefly. <i>He began to <b>recapitulate</b> his argument with care.</i>
<b>resume</b>	Take up or begin anew. <i>The painting <b>resumed</b> its old condition when we restored it.</i>
<b>scribble</b>	Write or draw (something) carelessly or hurriedly. <i>Illegible <b>scribbles</b>.</i>
<b>sketch</b>	Make a sketch of. <i><b>Sketch</b> the outline of the book.</i>

<b><u>sketchy</u></b>	Giving only major points; lacking completeness. A <b>sketchy</b> account.
<b>slab</b>	Remove slabs from a log or tree to prepare it for sawing into planks. Paving <b>slabs</b> .
<b><u>summarize</u></b>	Give a brief statement of the main points of (something). To <b>summarize</b> there are three main categories.
<b>summary</b>	A brief statement or account of the main points of something. A <b>summary</b> of Chapter Three.
<b><u>synopsis</u></b>	A brief summary or general survey of something. A <b>synopsis</b> of the insurance cover provided is set out below.
<b><u>valley</u></b>	An internal angle formed by the intersecting planes of a roof, or by the slope of a roof and a wall. The <b>valley</b> floor.
<b><u>vignette</u></b>	Portray someone in the style of a vignette. A classic <b>vignette</b> of embassy life.
