

<u>abridge</u>	Curtail (a right or privilege. The new law might abridge our freedom of expression.
<u>briefly</u>	For a short time. As I briefly mentioned earlier.
<u>cartoon</u>	Draw cartoons of. We watched Yogi Bear cartoon s on TV.
concisely	In a concise manner; in a few words. <i>The history is summed up concisely in this book.</i>
<u>concrete</u>	Cover an area with concrete. The precious English countryside may soon be concrete d over.



contour	Mark a map or diagram with contour lines. It defines a major contour of this administration.
<u>delineate</u>	Show the form or outline of. <i>His finger found a precisely outlined section</i> delineate <i>d in red marker.</i>
divergent	Diverging from another or from a standard. <i>Divergent</i> interpretations.
doodle	Make a doodle draw aimlessly. The text was interspersed with doodle s.
draft	Select a player for a sports team through the draft. A draft document.
draw	The act of drawing or hauling something. This chimney draw s very well.
<u>encapsulate</u>	Enclose in a capsule or other small container. The company would encapsulate the asbestos waste in concrete pellets.
incised	Cut into with a sharp instrument. An incised design.
outline	Draw up an outline or sketch for something. An outline proposal.
plaque	A sticky deposit on teeth in which bacteria proliferate. Plaque around gum margins can lead to gingivitis.
precis	Make a precis of a text or speech.
profile	Represent in profile by drawing or painting. In soft rocks a profile drawn normally to the beach would show a concave form comparable with the long profile of a river.
prospectus	A printed booklet advertising a school or university to potential parents or students or giving details of a share offer for the benefit of investors. A prospectus should contain the facts that an investor needs to make an informed decision.
recapitulate	Summarize briefly. <i>He began to recapitulate his argument with care.</i>
resume	Take up or begin anew. The painting resume d its old condition when we restored it.
scribble	Write or draw (something) carelessly or hurriedly. <i>Illegible scribbles.</i>
<u>sketch</u>	Make a sketch of. Sketch the outline of the book.



<u>sketchy</u>	Giving only major points; lacking completeness. A sketchy account.
slab	Remove slabs from a log or tree to prepare it for sawing into planks. <i>Paving slabs.</i>
<u>summarize</u>	Give a brief statement of the main points of (something. To summarize there are three main categories.
summary	A brief statement or account of the main points of something. A summary of Chapter Three.
<u>synopsis</u>	A brief summary or general survey of something. A synopsis of the insurance cover provided is set out below.
<u>valley</u>	An internal angle formed by the intersecting planes of a roof, or by the slope of a roof and a wall. <i>The valley floor.</i>
<u>vignette</u>	Portray someone in the style of a vignette. A classic vignette of embassy life.
