Infinitive	<b>to enjoy</b>
Present Tense	<b>enjoy / enjoys</b>
Past Tense	<b>enjoyed</b>
Present Participle	<b>enjoying</b>
Past Participle	<b>enjoyed</b>

## Conjugate Enjoy

**Enjoy in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular          Plural**

I **enjoy**                  We **enjoy**  
You **enjoy**              You **enjoy**  
He/She/It **enjoys**    They **enjoy**

**Enjoy in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **am enjoying**          We **are enjoying**  
You **are enjoying**      You **are enjoying**  
He/She/It **is enjoying**    They **are enjoying**

**Enjoy in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have enjoyed**          We **have enjoyed**  
You **have enjoyed**      You **have enjoyed**  
He/She/It **has enjoyed**    They **have enjoyed**

**Enjoy in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **have been enjoying**      We **have been enjoying**  
You **have been enjoying**    You **have been enjoying**  
He/She/It **has been enjoying**    They **have been enjoying**

**Enjoy in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular                  Plural**

I **enjoyed**                  We **enjoyed**  
You **enjoyed**              You **enjoyed**  
He/She/It **enjoyed**      They **enjoyed**

**Enjoy in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was enjoying                      We were enjoying  
You were enjoying                You were enjoying  
He/She/It was enjoying        They were enjoying

**Enjoy in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had enjoyed                      We had enjoyed  
You had enjoyed                You had enjoyed  
He/She/It had enjoyed        They had enjoyed

**Enjoy in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been enjoying                We had been enjoying  
You had been enjoying            You had been enjoying  
He/She/It had been enjoying    They had been enjoying

**Enjoy in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will enjoy                      We will enjoy  
You will enjoy                You will enjoy  
He/She/It will enjoy        They will enjoy

**Enjoy in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be enjoying                We will be enjoying  
You will be enjoying            You will be enjoying  
He/She/It will be enjoying    They will be enjoying

**Enjoy in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have enjoyed**

**We will have enjoyed**

**You will have enjoyed**

**You will have enjoyed**

**He/She/It will have enjoyed**

**They will have enjoyed**

**Enjoy in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been enjoying**

**We will have been enjoying**

**You will have been enjoying**

**You will have been enjoying**

**He/She/It will have been enjoying**

**They will have been enjoying**
