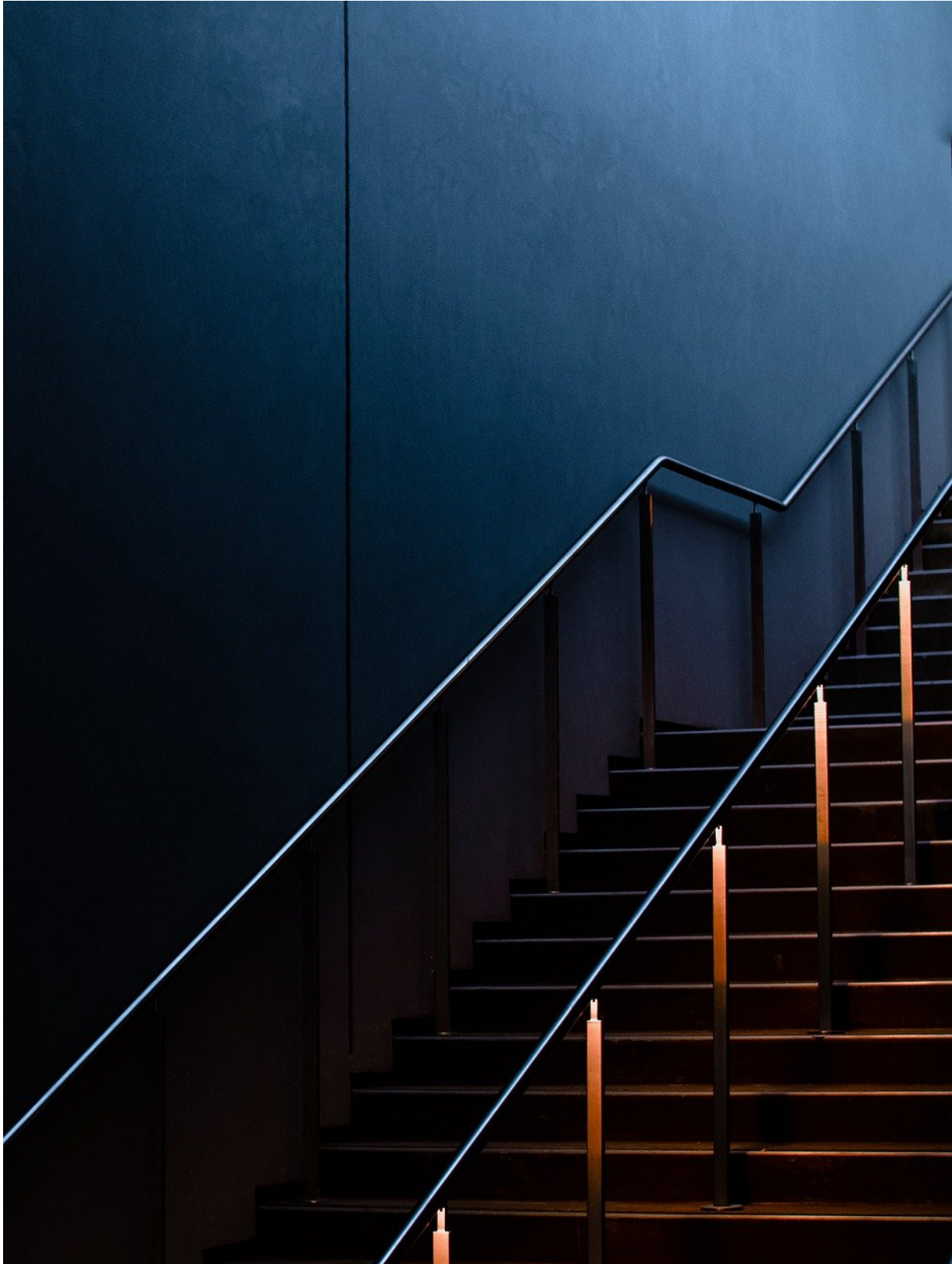

delighted Greatly pleased.
*We were **delighted** to see her.*

enthralled Filled with wonder and delight.

admittance The act of admitting someone to enter.
*People were unable to gain **admittance** to the hall.*

allure Dispose or incline or entice to.
*People for whom gold holds no **allure**.*

appeal	Apply to a higher court for a reversal of the decision of a lower court. <i>She appealed to Germany for political asylum.</i>
attract	Be attractive to. <i>I was attracted to the idea of working for a ballet company.</i>
attraction	A characteristic that provides pleasure and attracts. <i>The church is the town's main tourist attraction.</i>
attractive	(of a person) appealing to look at; sexually alluring. <i>A stunningly attractive charismatic man.</i>
beguile	Attract; cause to be enamored. <i>To beguile some of the time they went to the cinema.</i>
cachet	A seal on a letter. <i>Special cachets are applied to cards sold at the stands.</i>
captivate	Attract and hold the interest and attention of; charm. <i>He was captivated by her beauty.</i>
charisma	A divinely conferred power or talent. <i>He has tremendous charisma and stage presence.</i>
charm	Induce into action by using one's charm. <i>She charmed him into giving her all his money.</i>
enchant	Cast a spell over someone or something; put a hex on someone or something. <i>You have been enchanted by some spirits.</i>
enthrall	Hold spellbound.
entree	An entrance, especially a theatrical entrance onto a stage or as if onto a stage. <i>She made a graceful entree into the ballroom.</i>
fascinate	To render motionless, as with a fixed stare or by arousing terror or awe. <i>The snake charmer fascinates the cobra.</i>
gate	Control with a valve or other device that functions like a gate. <i>They were opening the gates of their country wide to the enemy.</i>
gateway	A place regarded as giving access to another place. <i>Mombasa the gateway to East Africa.</i>
hypnotize	Produce a state of hypnosis in (someone). <i>A witness had been hypnotized to enhance his memory.</i>
inviting	Attractive and tempting. <i>The sea down there looks so inviting.</i>
magician	A person with exceptional skill in a particular area. <i>He was the magician of the fan belt.</i>
mesmerize	Induce hypnosis in. <i>He was mesmerized when at the point of death.</i>

- portal** A short vein that carries blood into the liver.
*Many healthcare providers already utilize **portals** through which a patient can access test results.*
- seduction** A tempting or attractive thing.
*If **seduction** doesn't work she can play on his sympathy.*
- seductive** Tempting and attractive; enticing.
*A **seductive** voice.*
- spellbind** To render motionless, as with a fixed stare or by arousing terror or awe.
The singer held the audience spellbound.
- tempting** Very pleasantly inviting.
*A **tempting** invitation.*
- trance** Put into a trance.
*She put him into a light **trance**.*
- venous** Of or contained in or performing the function of the veins.
- wile** Lure; entice.
*The devious **wiles** of the politicians.*
- window** A space behind the window of a shop where goods are displayed for sale.
*He stuck his head in the **window**.*
