| entranceway | A door or corridor at the entrance to a building. |
| entree | The right to enter. <i>She made a graceful entree into the ballroom.</i> |
| entry | The act of beginning something new. <i>Sophisticated features to help ensure accurate data entry.</i> |
| ingress | (astronomy) the disappearance of a celestial body prior to an eclipse. |
| means of access | An instrumentality for accomplishing some end. |
| means of entry | Considerable capital (wealth or income). |
| way in | A portion of something divided into shares. |
