environ Surround; enclose.

The stone circle was **environ**ed by an expanse of peat soil.

filledOf purchase orders that have been filled.

hermetically In a way that is completely airtight. A hermetically closed society.

include Comprise or contain as part of a whole.

I **include** you in the list of culprits.

included Enclosed in the same envelope or package.

Service tax **included**.

A body or particle of distinct composition embedded in a rock or other

inclusion material.

The exhibition features such **inclusion**s as the study of the little girl.

incorporate Constitute (a company, city, or other organization) as a legal corporation.

Incorporate this document with those pertaining to the same case.

involve Require as useful, just, or proper.

My job involves a lot of travelling.

packagingThe presentation of a person or thing in an advantageous way.

They specialized in food **packaging**.

seal Close with or as if with a seal.

She **seal**ed the letter with hot wax.

shroud Wrap or dress a body in a shroud for burial. *They operate behind a shroud of secrecy.*

They operate bennia a shroud of secrecy.

subsume Include or absorb (something) in something else.

Most of these phenomena can be **subsume**d under two broad categories.

surround Surround with a wall in order to fortify.

The hotel is **surround**ed by its own gardens.

swathe A strip left clear by the passage of a mowing machine or scythe.

Vast **swathe**s of countryside.

unopened Not opened.
