## The Forms of Equal

Infinitive	<b>to equal</b>
Present Tense	<b>equal / equals</b>
Past Tense	<b>equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>
Present Participle	<b>equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>
Past Participle	<b>equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>

## Conjugate Equal

### Equal in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>equal</b>	We <b>equal</b>
You <b>equal</b>	You <b>equal</b>
He/She/It <b>equals</b>	They <b>equal</b>

### **Equal in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>	We <b>are equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>
You <b>are equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>	You <b>are equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>
He/She/It <b>is equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>	They <b>are equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>

### **Equal in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>	We <b>have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>
You <b>have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>	You <b>have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>
He/She/It <b>has equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>	They <b>have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>

### **Equal in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>	We <b>have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>
You <b>have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>	You <b>have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>
He/She/It <b>has been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>	They <b>have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)</b>

### **Equal in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>	We <b>equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>
You <b>equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>	You <b>equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>
He/She/It <b>equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>	They <b>equalled (uk) or equaled (us)</b>

## **Equal in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

### **Singular**

**I was equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**  
**You were equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**  
**He/She/It was equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

### **Plural**

**We were equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**  
**You were equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**  
**They were equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

## **Equal in Past Perfect Tense**

### **Singular**

**I had equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**  
**You had equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**  
**He/She/It had equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**

### **Plural**

**We had equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**  
**You had equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**  
**They had equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**

## **Equal in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

### **Singular**

**I had been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**  
**You had been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**  
**He/She/It had been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

### **Plural**

**We had been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**  
**You had been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**  
**They had been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

## **Equal in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will equal**  
**You will equal**  
**He/She/It will equal**

### **Plural**

**We will equal**  
**You will equal**

**They will equal**

## **Equal in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will be equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

### **Plural**

**We will be equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**Singular**

**You will be equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**He/She/It will be equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**Plural**

**You will be equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**They will be equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**Equal in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**I will have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**

**You will have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**

**He/She/It will have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**

**Plural**

**We will have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**

**You will have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**

**They will have equalled (uk) or equaled (us)**

**Equal in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**I will have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**You will have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**He/She/It will have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**Plural**

**We will have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**You will have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**

**They will have been equalling (uk) or equaling (us)**
