## Associations of "Equaled" (30 Words)

<a href="#">akin</a>	Of similar character. <i>Something <b>akin</b> to gratitude overwhelmed her.</i>
<b>alike</b>	Having the same or similar characteristics. <i>They looked utterly <b>alike</b>.</i>
<b>as</b>	A United States territory on the eastern part of the island of Samoa. <i>He is every bit <b>as</b> mean <b>as</b> she is.</i>
<b>balanced</b>	Being in a state of proper equilibrium. <i>The educated man shows a <b>balanced</b> development of all his powers.</i>
<a href="#">commensurate</a>	Corresponding in size or degree or extent. <i>Salary will be <b>commensurate</b> with age and experience.</i>
<a href="#">comparable</a>	Conforming in every respect. <i>The situation in Holland is <b>comparable</b> to that in England.</i>
<b>compare</b>	Draw an analogy between one thing and (another) for the purposes of explanation or clarification. <i>Individual schools <b>compared</b> their facilities with those of others in the area.</i>
<b>compatible</b>	A computer that can use software designed for another make or type. <i>Her deeds were <b>compatible</b> with her ideology.</i>
<a href="#">congruent</a>	Coinciding when superimposed. <i>Institutional and departmental objectives are very largely <b>congruent</b>.</i>
<b>consistently</b>	In a fair and impartial way. <i>Students have to be treated <b>consistently</b> by all staff members.</i>
<a href="#">ditto</a>	The same thing again used in lists and accounts and often indicated by a ditto mark under the word or figure to be repeated. <i>The next speaker <b>dittoed</b> her argument.</i>
<a href="#">equalize</a>	Make equal, uniform, corresponding, or matching. <i>The purpose is to <b>equalize</b> the workload among tutors.</i>

<b><u>equally</u></b>	In addition and having the same importance (used to introduce a further comment). <i>The money can be divided <b>equally</b> between you.</i>
<b><u>equity</u></b>	The ownership interest of shareholders in a corporation. <i>People who have built up a significant amount of <b>equity</b> in their homes.</i>
<b>evenhanded</b>	Without partiality. <i><b>Evenhanded</b> justice.</i>
<b><u>evenly</u></b>	In equal numbers, amounts, or values. <i>An <b>evenly</b> contested game.</i>
<b>fair</b>	Without favoring one party in a fair evenhanded manner. <i>Today will be <b>fair</b> and warm.</i>
<b><u>identical</u></b>	Expressing an identity. <i>The passage on the second floor was <b>identical</b> to the one below.</i>
<b>indistinguishable</b>	Exactly alike; incapable of being perceived as different. <i>They wore <b>indistinguishable</b> hats.</i>
<b><u>justice</u></b>	A public official authorized to decide questions brought before a court of justice. <i>A concern for <b>justice</b> peace and genuine respect for people.</i>
<b>liken</b>	Consider or describe as similar, equal, or analogous. <i>Racism is <b>likened</b> to a contagious disease.</i>
<b>match</b>	The score needed to win a match. <i>When the software finds a <b>match</b> it writes the correct character.</i>
<b>par</b>	A par score at a hole. <i>The sixteenth is a <b>par</b> five.</i>
<b>proportionate</b>	Agreeing in amount, magnitude, or degree. <i><b>Proportionate</b> representation of a minority group.</i>
<b>same</b>	Same in identity. <i>Curtains the <b>same</b> color as the walls.</i>
<b>similar</b>	Having the same or similar characteristics. <i>The principle of treatment by <b>similars</b>.</i>
<b>similitude</b>	Similarity in appearance or character or nature between persons or things. <i>There is a striking <b>similitude</b> between the brother and sister.</i>
<b>symmetrical</b>	Having similarity in size, shape, and relative position of corresponding parts. <i>The shape of a hill smooth and <b>symmetrical</b>.</i>

Being essentially equal to something.  
*His statement was **tantamount** to an admission of guilt.*

**twin**

Grow as twins.  
*Her **twin** sister.*
