## The Forms of Equiparate

Infinitive	to equiparate
Present Tense	equiparate / equiparates
Past Tense	equiparated
Present Participle	equiparating
Past Participle	equiparated

# **Conjugate Equiparate**

#### **Equiparate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>equiparate</b>	We <b>equiparate</b>
You <b>equiparate</b>	You <b>equiparate</b>
He/She/It equiparates	They <b>equiparate</b>

#### **Equiparate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am equiparating	We are equiparating
You <b>are equiparating</b>	You <b>are equiparating</b>
He/She/It is equiparating	They are equiparating

#### **Equiparate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have equiparated	We have equiparated
You have equiparated	You have equiparated
He/She/It has equiparated	They have equiparated

## **Equiparate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been equiparating	We have been equiparating
You <b>have been equiparating</b>	You <b>have been equiparating</b>
He/She/It has been equiparating	They have been equiparating

#### **Equiparate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I equiparated	We <b>equiparated</b>
You <b>equiparated</b>	You <b>equiparated</b>
He/She/It equiparated	They <b>equiparated</b>

#### **Equiparate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was equiparating	We were equiparating
You <b>were equiparating</b>	You were equiparating
He/She/It was equiparating	They were equiparating

#### **Equiparate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had equiparated	We had equiparated
You <b>had equiparated</b>	You had equiparated
He/She/It had equiparated	They had equiparated

#### **Equiparate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been equiparating	We had been equiparating
You <b>had been equiparating</b>	You had been equiparating
He/She/It had been equiparating	They had been equiparating

## **Equiparate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will equiparate	We <b>will equiparate</b>
You <b>will equiparate</b>	You <b>will equiparate</b>
He/She/It will equiparate	They will equiparate

## **Equiparate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be equiparating	We <b>will be equiparating</b>
You <b>will be equiparating</b>	You <b>will be equiparating</b>
He/She/It will be equiparating	They <b>will be equiparating</b>

#### **Equiparate in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Equiparate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been equiparating	We will have been equiparating
You <b>will have been equiparating</b>	You <b>will have been equiparating</b>
He/She/It will have been equiparating	They will have been equiparating
