equipt Provided or fitted out with what is necessary or useful or appropriate.


fitted out Not worth considering as a possibility.

weaponed Carrying weapons.






Usage Examples of "Equipped" as an adjective

allotted	Given as a task. Her allotted chores.
amply	Enough or more than enough; plentifully. <i>The evidence amply or fully confirms our suspicions.</i>
appointed	Subject to appointment. At the time appointed or the appointed time.
appropriately	In accordance with what is appropriate or suitable for the circumstances. <i>Volunteers need to be approachable calm and able to respond appropriately</i> .
aptly	With competence; in a competent capable manner. America s aptly named Sunshine State.
assigned	Appointed to a post or duty. Assigned personnel.



automated	Operated by largely automatic equipment. An automated stoker.
completely	Totally; utterly. Was completely at fault.
configure	Arrange or put together in a particular form or configuration. <i>Configure</i> a plane for a combat mission.
<u>conversant</u>	Well informed about or knowing thoroughly. You need someone who is conversant with the new technology.
duly	In accordance with what is required or appropriate; following proper procedure or arrangement. A document duly signed and authorized by the inspector.
entire	Constituting the undiminished entirety lacking nothing essential especially not damaged. <i>Was able to keep the collection entire during his lifetime.</i>
executor	A person appointed by a testator to carry out the terms of the will. <i>The executors of the late John B Smith</i> .
fully	Sufficiently; more than adequately. I fully understand the fears of the workers.
furnished	Provided with whatever is necessary for a purpose (as furniture or equipment or authority. A furnished apartment.
given	Specified or stated. At a couture house attentive service is a given .
<u>install</u>	Put into an office or a position. <i>Install</i> the washer and dryer.
occupancy	The action or fact of occupying a place. Occupation of a building without a certificate of occupancy is illegal.
ordained	Fixed or established especially by order or command. An ordained priest.
penetrable	Capable of being penetrated. The outer membrane is penetrable .
prepared	Equipped or prepared with necessary intellectual resources. The spokesman was reading a prepared statement.
prescribed	Conforming to set usage, procedure, or discipline. In prescribed order.
properly	With reason or justice. On the first day she felt properly well Millie sat out on the front steps.



ready	Make ready or suitable or equip in advance for a particular purpose or for some use event etc. <i>Ready</i> for action.
ripen	Cause to ripen or develop fully. <i>The plums ripen in July.</i>
set	Set to a certain position or cause to operate correctly. The scheme set s a precedent for other companies.
settled	Inhabited by colonists. The advent of settled civilization.
setup	The way something is organized or arranged. It takes time to learn the setup around here.
standby	Readiness for duty or immediate deployment. A standby crew.
suitably	In accordance with what is appropriate or suitable for the circumstances. <i>The judges were suitably impressed.</i>
