<b><u>install</u></b>	Put into an office or a position. <i><b>Install</b> the washer and dryer.</i>
<b>institute</b>	Set up or lay the groundwork for. <i>The award was <b>instituted</b> in 1900.</i>
<b>launch</b>	Launch for the first time launch on a maiden voyage. <i>A chair was <b>launched</b> at him.</i>
<b>lay down</b>	Put into a certain place or abstract location.
<b>make</b>	Make by shaping or bringing together constituents. <i>Anyone can <b>make</b> a mistake.</i>
<b>plant</b>	Place a plant in the ground out of doors so it can grow especially after growing it from seed in an indoor environment. <i>It was raining when we <b>planted</b> him.</i>
<b>prove</b>	Prove formally demonstrate by a mathematical formal proof. <i>The scheme has <b>proved</b> a great success.</i>
<b>set up</b>	Disappear beyond the horizon.
<b>shew</b>	Establish the validity of something, as by an example, explanation or experiment.
<b>show</b>	Show in or as in a picture. <i>It was Frank s turn to <b>show</b> his frustration.</i>

<b>cook</b>	Someone who cooks food. <i>A narcotics team who <b>cooked</b> the evidence.</i>
<b>coordinate</b>	Form a coordinate bond to an atom or molecule. <i>Cross references in the catalogue link subjects which may be <b>coordinate</b>.</i>
<b>create</b>	Create by artistic means. <i>He was <b>created</b> a baronet.</i>
<b>devise</b>	(law) a gift of real property by will. <i>A training programme should be <b>devised</b>.</i>
<b>fixing</b>	Restraint that attaches to something or holds something in place. <i>Several laws restricted the <b>fixing</b> of retail prices.</i>
<b>found</b>	Set up or found. <i><b>Found</b> art.</i>
<b>furnish</b>	Supply someone with (something); give (something) to someone. <i>She was able to <b>furnish</b> me with details of the incident.</i>
<b>install</b>	Set up for use. <i><b>Install</b> the washer and dryer.</i>

<b>institute</b>	Advance or set forth in court. <i>The state <b>instituted</b> a national lottery.</i>
<b><u>invent</u></b>	Make up (an idea, name, story, etc.), especially so as to deceive someone. <i>He <b>invented</b> an improved form of the steam engine.</i>
<b>make</b>	Make formulate or derive in the mind. <i>He wasn't going to <b>make</b> captain.</i>
<b>ordered</b>	Marked by an orderly, logical, and aesthetically consistent relation of parts. <i>An <b>ordered</b> sequence.</i>
<b><u>organize</u></b>	Bring order and organization to. <i><b>Organize</b> lessons in a planned way.</i>
<b><u>prepare</u></b>	To prepare verbally either for written or spoken delivery. <i><b>Prepare</b> a speech.</i>
<b>ready</b>	Make ready or suitable or equip in advance for a particular purpose or for some use event etc. <i>A <b>ready</b> source of cash.</i>
<b>reclaim</b>	The action or process of reclaiming or being reclaimed. <i>Allow a week or ten days for <b>reclaiming</b> the bird.</i>
<b>replenishment</b>	Restoration of a stock or supply to a former level or condition. <i>A target for <b>replenishment</b> of depleted fish stocks.</i>
<b>set</b>	Put or set seeds seedlings or plants into the ground. <i>The sun <b>sets</b> early these days.</i>
<b>setup</b>	The way something is organized or arranged. <i>It takes time to learn the <b>setup</b> around here.</i>
<b>sizing</b>	Any glutinous material used to fill pores in surfaces or to stiffen fabrics.
<b>suitably</b>	In a way that is right or appropriate for a particular purpose or situation. <i>The post is open to <b>suitably</b> qualified applicants from all over the world.</i>
<b>troubleshoot</b>	Solve problems. <i>Follow the error messages to <b>troubleshoot</b>.</i>
