### **Etymologise in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular Plural

I am etymologising We are etymologising
You are etymologising You are etymologising
He/She/It is etymologising They are etymologising

### **Etymologise in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I have etymologised We have etymologised You have etymologised You have etymologised He/She/It has etymologised They have etymologised

# **Etymologise in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I have been etymologising
You have been etymologising
He/She/It has been etymologising
They have been etymologising

## **Etymologise in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular Plural

I **etymologised** We **etymologised**You **etymologised** You **etymologised**He/She/It **etymologised** They **etymologised** 

# **Etymologise in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular Plural

I was etymologising We were etymologising
You were etymologising
He/She/It was etymologising They were etymologising

### **Etymologise in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular Plural

I had etymologised We had etymologised You had etymologised He/She/It had etymologised They had etymologised

### **Etymologise in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular Plural

I had been etymologising
You had been etymologising
He/She/It had been etymologising
They had been etymologising

# **Etymologise in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular Plural

I will etymologise
You will etymologise
He/She/It will etymologise
They will etymologise

## **Etymologise in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular Plural

I will be etymologising
You will be etymologising
He/She/It will be etymologising
They will be etymologising

You will have etymologised

They will have etymologised
