Etymologize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

I am etymologizing We are etymologizing
You are etymologizing You are etymologizing
He/She/It is etymologizing They are etymologizing

Etymologize in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have etymologized We have etymologized You have etymologized You have etymologized He/She/It has etymologized They have etymologized

Etymologize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been etymologizing
You have been etymologizing
You have been etymologizing
He/She/It has been etymologizing
They have been etymologizing

I **etymologized** We **etymologized**You **etymologized** You **etymologized**He/She/It **etymologized** They **etymologized**

Etymologize in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was etymologizing We were etymologizing
You were etymologizing
He/She/It was etymologizing They were etymologizing
