# **Conjugate Evene**

### **Evene in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I evene	We <b>evene</b>
You <b>evene</b>	You <b>evene</b>
He/She/It evenes	They evene

## **Evene in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am evening	We <b>are evening</b>
You <b>are evening</b>	You <b>are evening</b>
He/She/It is evening	They <b>are evening</b>

### **Evene in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have evened	We have evened
You have evened	You have evened
He/She/It has evened	They have evened

## **Evene in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been evening	We have been evening
You <b>have been evening</b>	You have been evening
He/She/It has been evening	They have been evening

# **Evene in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I evened	We <b>evened</b>
You <b>evened</b>	You <b>evened</b>
He/She/It <b>evened</b>	They <b>evened</b>

#### **Evene in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was evening	We were evening
You <b>were evening</b>	You were evening
He/She/It was evening	They were evening

#### **Evene in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had evened	We had evened
You had evened	You <b>had evened</b>
He/She/It had evened	They had evened

### **Evene in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been evening	We had been evening
You <b>had been evening</b>	You had been evening
He/She/It had been evening	They had been evening

# **Evene in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will evene</b>	We <b>will evene</b>
You <b>will evene</b>	You <b>will evene</b>
He/She/It will evene	They will evene

# **Evene in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be evening	We will be evening
You <b>will be evening</b>	You <b>will be evening</b>
He/She/It will be evening	They will be evening
