# **Conjugate Evict**

## **Evict in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I evict	We evict
You <b>evict</b>	You <b>evict</b>
He/She/It evicts	They evict

## **Evict in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am evicting	We are evicting
You <b>are evicting</b>	You <b>are evicting</b>
He/She/It is evicting	They <b>are evicting</b>

### **Evict in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have evicted	We have evicted
You have evicted	You have evicted
He/She/It has evicted	They have evicted

### **Evict in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been evicting	We have been evicting
You <b>have been evicting</b>	You have been evicting
He/She/It has been evicting	They have been evicting

# **Evict in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I evicted	We <b>evicted</b>
You <b>evicted</b>	You <b>evicted</b>
He/She/It <b>evicted</b>	They $\ensuremath{\textbf{evicted}}$

## **Evict in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was evicting	We were evicting
You were evicting	You were evicting
He/She/It was evicting	They were evicting

### **Evict in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had evicted	We <b>had evicted</b>
You had evicted	You <b>had evicted</b>
He/She/It had evicted	They had evicted

## **Evict in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been evicting	We had been evicting
You <b>had been evicting</b>	You had been evicting
He/She/It had been evicting	They had been evicting

# **Evict in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will evict	We will evict
You <b>will evict</b>	You <b>will evict</b>
He/She/It will evict	They will evict

# **Evict in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be evicting	We will be evicting
You <b>will be evicting</b>	You will be evicting
He/She/It will be evicting	They will be evicting

#### **Evict in Future Perfect Tense**

### **Evict in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been evicting	We <b>will have been evicting</b>
You <b>will have been evicting</b>	You will have been evicting
He/She/It will have been evicting	They will have been evicting
