Past Tense	excommunicated
Present Participle	excommunicating
Past Participle	excommunicated

# **Conjugate Excommunicate**

**Excommunicate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense** 



Singular	Plural
I excommunicate	We <b>excommunicate</b>
You <b>excommunicate</b>	You <b>excommunicate</b>
He/She/It excommunicates	They <b>excommunicate</b>

### **Excommunicate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am excommunicating	We are excommunicating
You are excommunicating	You are excommunicating
He/She/It is excommunicating	They <b>are excommunicating</b>

#### **Excommunicate in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have excommunicated	We have excommunicated
You have excommunicated	You have excommunicated
He/She/It has excommunicated	They have excommunicated

#### **Excommunicate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been excommunicating	We have been excommunicating
You have been excommunicating	You have been excommunicating
He/She/It has been excommunicating	They have been excommunicating

## **Excommunicate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I excommunicated	We <b>excommunicated</b>
You <b>excommunicated</b>	You <b>excommunicated</b>
He/She/It excommunicated	They <b>excommunicated</b>

#### **Excommunicate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



SingularPluralI was excommunicatingWe were excommunicatingYou were excommunicatingYou were excommunicatingHe/She/It was excommunicatingThey were excommunicating

#### **Excommunicate in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had excommunicated	We had excommunicated
You had excommunicated	You had excommunicated
He/She/It had excommunicated	They had excommunicated

#### **Excommunicate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been excommunicating	We had been excommunicating
You had been excommunicating	You had been excommunicating
He/She/It had been excommunicating	They had been excommunicating

#### **Excommunicate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will excommunicate	We will excommunicate
You <b>will excommunicate</b>	You will excommunicate
He/She/It will excommunicate	They will excommunicate

#### **Excommunicate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

SingularPluralI will be excommunicatingWe will be excommunicatingYou will be excommunicatingYou will be excommunicatingHe/She/It will be excommunicatingThey will be excommunicating

#### **Excommunicate in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have excommunicated	We will have excommunicated
You will have excommunicated	You will have excommunicated
He/She/It will have excommunicated	l They will have excommunicated

## **Excommunicate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been excommunicating	We will have been excommunicating
You will have been excommunicating	You will have been excommunicating
He/She/It will have been excommunicating	They will have been excommunicating
