give an instance of	Contribute to some cause.
<u>illustrate</u>	Explain or make (something) clear by using examples, charts, pictures, etc. <i>Illustrate</i> a book with drawings.
<u>instance</u>	Clarify by giving an example of. I <b>instance</b> d Bob as someone whose commitment had certainly got things done.
represent	Be representative or typical for. This sum <b>represent</b> s my entire income for a year.
serve as a typical example of	Do military service.
symbolize	Express indirectly by an image, form, or model; be a symbol. A tendency to <b>symbolize</b> the father as the sun.
typify	Express indirectly by an image, form, or model; be a symbol. Tough, low-lying vegetation typifies this arctic area.

archetypal	Relating to or denoting Jungian archetypes. An <b>archetypal</b> journey representing the quest for identity.
best	To the highest degree; most (used with verbs suggesting a desirable action or state or a successful outcome. <i>Father knows <b>best</b></i> .
<u>contingent</u>	(of losses, liabilities, etc.) that can be anticipated to arise if a particular event occurs. <i>His fees were <b>contingent</b> on the success of his search.</i>
<u>emblem</u>	A visible symbol representing an abstract idea. America s national <b>emblem</b> the bald eagle.
embodiment	A new personification of a familiar idea. A circle was the <b>embodiment</b> of his concept of life.



<u>embody</u>	Represent or express something abstract in tangible form. A national team that embodies competitive spirit and skill.
<u>epitome</u>	A summary of a written work; an abstract. She looked the <b>epitome</b> of elegance and good taste.
excellence	An outstanding feature or quality. A center of manufacturing <b>excellence</b> .
<u>exemplar</u>	A person or thing serving as a typical example or appropriate model. An <b>exemplar</b> of success.
<u>exemplary</u>	Serving to warn. <i>Exemplary</i> sentencing may discourage the violent minority.
illustration	A visual representation (a picture or diagram) that is used make some subject more pleasing or easier to understand. <i>An illustration</i> of a yacht.
<u>implicit</u>	With no qualification or question; absolute. Comments seen as <b>implicit</b> criticism of the policies.
<u>imply</u>	Suggest that someone is guilty. Salesmen who use jargon to <b>imply</b> superior knowledge.
incarnate	Invested with a bodily form especially of a human body. <i>Here is capitalism <b>incarnate</b></i> .
<u>instance</u>	Clarify by giving an example of. A serious <b>instance</b> of corruption.
mark	Make small marks into the surface of. An envelope <b>mark</b> ed private and confidential.
model	Work as a model by displaying clothes or posing for an artist or sculptor. A <b>model</b> of St Paul s Cathedral.
<u>paradigm</u>	The class of all items that can be substituted into the same position or slot in a grammatical sentence are in paradigmatic relation with one another. Society s <b>paradigm</b> of the ideal woman.
paradigmatic	Related as members of a substitution class. His biography is <b>paradigmatic</b> of the experiences of this generation.
<u>paragon</u>	Model of excellence or perfection of a kind; one having no equal. Your cook is a <b>paragon</b> .
represent	Be representative or typical for. This period is <b>represent</b> ed by Beethoven.
representative	Being or characteristic of government by representation in which citizens exercise power through elected officers and representatives. <i>A PLO representative attending a meeting in Damascus.</i>

<u>symbolic</u>	Using symbolism. The release of the dissident was an important <b>symbolic</b> gesture.
symbolism	Symbolic meaning attributed to natural objects or facts. The old fashioned <b>symbolism</b> of flowers.
symbolize	Be a symbol of. These painters believed that artists should <b>symbolize</b> .
technicolor	A trademarked method of making color motion pictures.
typify	Express indirectly by an image, form, or model; be a symbol. The sun typified the Greeks, and the moon the Persians.
virtue	(in traditional Christian angelology) the seventh-highest order of the ninefold celestial hierarchy. <i>There s no virtue in suffering in silence.</i>
zodiac	Astrology a circular diagram representing the 12 zodiacal constellations and showing their signs.
