give an instance of	Contribute to some cause.
<u>illustrate</u>	Explain or make (something) clear by using examples, charts, pictures, etc. <i>Illustrate</i> a book with drawings.
<u>instance</u>	Clarify by giving an example of. I instance d Bob as someone whose commitment had certainly got things done.
represent	Be representative or typical for. This sum represent s my entire income for a year.
serve as a typical example of	Do military service.
symbolize	Express indirectly by an image, form, or model; be a symbol. A tendency to symbolize the father as the sun.
typify	Express indirectly by an image, form, or model; be a symbol. Tough, low-lying vegetation typifies this arctic area.

archetypal	Relating to or denoting Jungian archetypes. An archetypal journey representing the quest for identity.
best	To the highest degree; most (used with verbs suggesting a desirable action or state or a successful outcome. <i>Father knows best</i> .
<u>contingent</u>	(of losses, liabilities, etc.) that can be anticipated to arise if a particular event occurs. <i>His fees were contingent on the success of his search.</i>
<u>emblem</u>	A visible symbol representing an abstract idea. America s national emblem the bald eagle.
embodiment	A new personification of a familiar idea. A circle was the embodiment of his concept of life.



<u>embody</u>	Represent or express something abstract in tangible form. A national team that embodies competitive spirit and skill.
<u>epitome</u>	A summary of a written work; an abstract. She looked the epitome of elegance and good taste.
excellence	An outstanding feature or quality. A center of manufacturing excellence .
<u>exemplar</u>	A person or thing serving as a typical example or appropriate model. An exemplar of success.
<u>exemplary</u>	Serving to warn. <i>Exemplary</i> sentencing may discourage the violent minority.
illustration	A visual representation (a picture or diagram) that is used make some subject more pleasing or easier to understand. <i>An illustration</i> of a yacht.
<u>implicit</u>	With no qualification or question; absolute. Comments seen as implicit criticism of the policies.
<u>imply</u>	Suggest that someone is guilty. Salesmen who use jargon to imply superior knowledge.
incarnate	Invested with a bodily form especially of a human body. <i>Here is capitalism incarnate</i> .
<u>instance</u>	Clarify by giving an example of. A serious instance of corruption.
mark	Make small marks into the surface of. An envelope mark ed private and confidential.
model	Work as a model by displaying clothes or posing for an artist or sculptor. A model of St Paul s Cathedral.
<u>paradigm</u>	The class of all items that can be substituted into the same position or slot in a grammatical sentence are in paradigmatic relation with one another. Society s paradigm of the ideal woman.
paradigmatic	Related as members of a substitution class. His biography is paradigmatic of the experiences of this generation.
<u>paragon</u>	Model of excellence or perfection of a kind; one having no equal. Your cook is a paragon .
represent	Be representative or typical for. This period is represent ed by Beethoven.
representative	Being or characteristic of government by representation in which citizens exercise power through elected officers and representatives. <i>A PLO representative attending a meeting in Damascus.</i>



<u>symbol</u>	Symbolize. The chemical symbol for helium is He.
<u>symbolic</u>	Using symbolism. The release of the dissident was an important symbolic gesture.
symbolism	Symbolic meaning attributed to natural objects or facts. The old fashioned symbolism of flowers.
symbolize	Be a symbol of. These painters believed that artists should symbolize .
technicolor	A trademarked method of making color motion pictures.
typify	Express indirectly by an image, form, or model; be a symbol. The sun typified the Greeks, and the moon the Persians.
virtue	(in traditional Christian angelology) the seventh-highest order of the ninefold celestial hierarchy. <i>There s no virtue in suffering in silence.</i>
zodiac	Astrology a circular diagram representing the 12 zodiacal constellations and showing their signs.
