Expediate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **expediate**You **expediate**He/She/It **expediates**They **expediate**

Expediate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am expediating We are expediating
You are expediating You are expediating
He/She/It is expediating They are expediating

Expediate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have expediated We have expediated You have expediated He/She/It has expediated They have expediated

Expediate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been expediating
You have been expediating
He/She/It has been expediating
They have been expediating

Expediate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **expediated** We **expediated**You **expediated** You **expediated**He/She/It **expediated** They **expediated**

Expediate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was expediating We were expediating
You were expediating You were expediating
He/She/It was expediating They were expediating

Expediate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had expediated We had expediated You had expediated You had expediated He/She/It had expediated They had expediated

Expediate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been expediating We had been expediating
You had been expediating You had been expediating
He/She/It had been expediating They had been expediating

Expediate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will expediate
You will expediate
He/She/It will expediate
They will expediate

Expediate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be expediating
You will be expediating
He/She/It will be expediating
They will be expediating

Expediate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have expediated We will have expediated You will have expediated He/She/It will have expediated They will have expediated

Expediate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been expediating
You will have been expediating
He/She/It will have been expediating
They will have been expediating
