<b>cheaply</b>	In a stingy manner. <i>Some people forgive too <b>cheaply</b>.</i>
<b>disconcerted</b>	Unsettled or confused. <i>Looked at each other dumbly quite <b>disconcerted</b>.</i>
<b>effective</b>	Able to accomplish a purpose functioning effectively. <i><b>Effective</b> teaching methods.</i>
<b>effectively</b>	In such a manner as to achieve a desired result. <i>They were <b>effectively</b> controlled by the people they were supposed to be investigating.</i>
<b>efficient</b>	Being effective without wasting time or effort or expense. <i>The <b>efficient</b> cause of the revolution.</i>
<b>efficiently</b>	With efficiency; in an efficient manner. <i>They recycle waste cheaply and <b>efficiently</b>.</i>
<b>expeditious</b>	Marked by speed and efficiency. <i>An <b>expeditious</b> investigation.</i>
<b>fast</b>	So as to be hard to wake. <i>A wide <b>fast</b> road.</i>
<b>favorably</b>	Showing approval. <i>He reviewed the play <b>favorably</b>.</i>
<b>hastily</b>	With excessive speed or urgency; hurriedly. <i>He <b>hastily</b> changed the subject.</i>
<b>hurriedly</b>	In a quick or rushed manner. <i>The way they buried him so <b>hurriedly</b> was disgraceful.</i>
<b>overrun</b>	A clear area beyond the end of a runway. <i>Let the text <b>overrun</b> the right hand margin.</i>
<b>proceed</b>	Follow a certain course. <i>Opposite the front door was a staircase which I <b>proceeded</b> to climb.</i>
<b>promptly</b>	At once (usually modifies an undesirable occurrence). <i>He did his homework <b>promptly</b>.</i>
<b>quick</b>	Moving quickly and lightly. <i>Was <b>quick</b> to respond.</i>
<b>quickly</b>	With little or no delay; promptly. <i>We moved <b>quickly</b> to deal with our auditor's questions.</i>
<b>rapid</b>	(of an action) characterized by great speed. <i>They lost three wickets in <b>rapid</b> succession.</i>
<b>rapidly</b>	Very quickly; at a great rate. <i>The business is expanding <b>rapidly</b>.</i>

<b>rush</b>	Cause to move fast or to rush or race. <i>A <b>rush</b> job.</i>
<b>satisfactorily</b>	In a satisfactory manner. <i>The matter is considered to be <b>satisfactorily</b> resolved.</i>
<b>scribble</b>	Write for a living or as a hobby. <i>He took the clipboard and <b>scribbled</b> something illegible.</i>
<b>smoothly</b>	Without problems or difficulties. <i>Everything seemed to be going <b>smoothly</b>.</i>
<b><u>speed</u></b>	Of a motorist travel at a speed that is greater than the legal limit. <i>The course is delivered online so students can progress at their own <b>speed</b>.</i>
<b>speedily</b>	With speed. <i>Your claim will be dealt with as <b>speedily</b> as possible.</i>
<b>successfully</b>	In a way that accomplishes a desired aim or result. <i>She has <b>successfully</b> completed her mission.</i>
<b><u>swift</u></b>	Swiftly. <i><b>Swift</b> flight of an arrow.</i>
<b><u>swiftly</u></b>	At high speed; quickly. <i>She got up and walked <b>swiftly</b> to the door.</i>
<b>telling</b>	Producing a strong effect. <i>A <b>telling</b> gesture.</i>
