### Synonyms of "Experiential" as an adjective (6 Words)

<b><u>actual</u></b>	Taking place in reality; not pretended or imitated. <i>The book could be condensed into half the space but what of the <b>actual</b> content.</i>
<b><u>existential</u></b>	Of or as conceived by existentialism. <i>Formal logicians are not concerned with <b>existential</b> matters.</i>
<b>factual</b>	Actually occurring. <i>Cases mentioned are <b>factual</b>.</i>
<b>observed</b>	Discovered or determined by scientific observation. <i>No explanation for the <b>observed</b> phenomena.</i>

- real** Coinciding with reality.  
*To the man sleeping regularly in doorways homelessness is **real**.*
- verifiable** Able to be checked or demonstrated to be true, accurate, or justified.  
*There is not a single **verifiable** fact.*

- *The experiential learning associated with employment.*
- *The rich experiential content of the teachings of the older philosophers.*
