astral	Relating to or resembling the stars. <i>An astral body.</i>
breadth	The extent of something from side to side. <i>The bank reaches a maximum breadth of about 100 km.</i>
broad	Broad in scope or content. <i>A broad lawn.</i>
capacious	Large in capacity. <i>She carried a capacious bag.</i>
constellation	A group of associated or similar people or things. <i>No two patients ever show exactly the same constellation of symptoms.</i>
cosmopolitan	A cosmopolitan person. <i>A cosmopolitan herb.</i>
expanded	Denoting materials which have a light cellular structure. <i>The curved soffit is finished with a strip of expanded metal mesh.</i>
expansive	A wide scope. <i>The green expansive of the forest.</i>
extensive	(of agriculture) obtaining a relatively small crop from a large area with a minimum of capital and labour. <i>Extensive farming techniques.</i>
far	More distant than another object of the same kind. <i>A far journey.</i>
galaxy	The galaxy of which the solar system is a part the Milky Way. <i>The four musicians have played with a galaxy of stars.</i>
locally	In a way that applies or is only available for use in one part of a program. <i>He served on several committees both nationally and locally.</i>
multinational	(of a business organization) operating in several countries. <i>1 500 troops were sent to join the multinational force.</i>

nationally	Extending throughout an entire nation. <i>Nationally advertised.</i>
opened	Made open or clear. <i>His mouth slightly opened.</i>
outspread	Fully extended in width. <i>Outspread wings.</i>
panoramic	(of a view or picture) with a wide view surrounding the observer; sweeping. <i>His panoramic vision of post World War I peace.</i>
plank	Cook and serve on a plank. <i>The central plank of the bill is the curb on industrial polluters.</i>
preponderance	A superiority in numbers or amount. <i>The preponderance of wealth and power.</i>
route	Send via a specific route. <i>The many routes to a healthier diet will be described.</i>
space	The physical universe beyond the earth's atmosphere. <i>There is no space to give further details.</i>
spaceman	An astronaut.
<u>spacious</u>	(especially of a room or building) having ample space. <i>Spacious skies.</i>
<u>stellar</u>	Being or relating to or resembling or emanating from stars. <i>His restaurant has received stellar ratings in the guides.</i>
<u>swath</u>	The space created by the swing of a scythe or the cut of a mowing machine.
<u>traveled</u>	Traveled over or through sometimes used as a combining term. <i>A traveled educated man.</i>
vast	An immense space. <i>A vast plain full of orchards.</i>
<u>wide</u>	A ball that is judged to be too wide of the stumps for the batsman to play for which an extra is awarded to the batting side. <i>How wide do you think this house is.</i>
wingspan	Linear distance between the extremities of an airfoil. <i>An eagle with a wingspan of 7 ft.</i>
<u>worldwide</u>	Of worldwide scope or applicability Christopher Morley. <i>Worldwide distribution.</i>
