**extraterrestrial being** A form of life assumed to exist outside the Earth or its atmosphere.

### Definitions of "Extraterrestrial" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "extraterrestrial" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Of or from outside the earth or its atmosphere.*
- *Originating or located or occurring outside Earth or its atmosphere.*



## Synonyms of "Extraterrestrial" as an adjective (4 Words)

- alien** Not contained in or deriving from the essential nature of something.  
*Alien beings.*
- not of this world** Involving the entire earth; not limited or provincial in scope.
- preternatural** Existing outside of or not in accordance with nature-Aldous Huxley.  
*Autumn had arrived with **preternatural** speed.*
- supernatural** (of a manifestation or event) attributed to some force beyond scientific understanding or the laws of nature.  
*A woman of **supernatural** beauty.*



## Usage Examples of "Extraterrestrial" as an adjective

- *Searches for extraterrestrial intelligence.*



## Associations of "Extraterrestrial" (30 Words)

- aerospace** The atmosphere and outer space considered as a whole.
- alien** Transfer property or ownership.  
*Principles that are **alien** to them.*
- astronaut** A person trained to travel in a spacecraft.  
*The Russians called their **astronauts** cosmonauts.*
- blimp** A small airship or barrage balloon.  
*I could work out four hours a day and still end up a **blimp**.*
- comet** (astronomy) a relatively small extraterrestrial body consisting of a frozen mass that travels around the sun in a highly elliptical orbit.
- cosmic** Inconceivably vast.  
*The song is a masterpiece of **cosmic** proportions.*
- dissimilar** Marked by dissimilarity.  
*A group of very **dissimilar** people.*
- existential** Of or as conceived by existentialism.  
*Formal logicians are not concerned with **existential** matters.*

<b>foreign</b>	Dealing with or relating to other countries. <i>A visit to a <b>foreign</b> clan.</i>
<b>foreigner</b>	A piece of work done for private gain without an employer's permission or without declaration to the relevant authorities.
<b>galaxy</b>	The galaxy of which the solar system is a part the Milky Way. <i>Extragalactic nebula is a former name for <b>galaxy</b>.</i>
<b>interstellar</b>	Between or among stars. <i><b>Interstellar</b> travel.</i>
<b>lander</b>	A spacecraft designed to land on the surface of a planet or moon. <i>A lunar <b>lander</b>.</i>
<b>lunar</b>	Of or relating to or associated with the moon. <i>A <b>lunar</b> eclipse.</i>
<b>orbit</b>	Of a celestial object or spacecraft move in orbit round a star or planet. <i>Mercury <b>orbits</b> the Sun.</i>
<b>outsider</b>	A person who does not belong to a particular organization or profession. <i>The winner was Beech Road a fifty to one <b>outsider</b>.</i>
<b>paranormal</b>	Seemingly outside normal sensory channels. <i>A mystic who can prove he has <b>paranormal</b> powers.</i>
<b>planetary</b>	Of or relating to or characteristic of the planet Earth or its inhabitants- L.C.Eiseley. <i>The laws of <b>planetary</b> motion.</i>
<b>psychic</b>	The study of psychic phenomena. <i><b>Psychic</b> powers.</i>
<b>saucer</b>	A shallow dish, typically having a circular indentation in the centre, on which a cup is placed.
<b>shuttle</b>	Transport in a shuttle. <i>A <b>shuttle</b> bus departs every 30 minutes.</i>
<b>space</b>	Capacity for storage of data in a computer or other digital device. <i>They tested his ability to locate objects in <b>space</b>.</i>
<b>spacecraft</b>	A vehicle used for travelling in space.
<b>spaceman</b>	An astronaut.
<b>spaceship</b>	A spacecraft, especially one controlled by a crew.
<b>star</b>	Feature as the star. <i>The walls were painted with silver moons and <b>stars</b>.</i>
<b>strange</b>	Slightly or undefinably unwell or ill at ease. <i>What a <b>strange</b> sense of humor she has.</i>

**stranger** A person entirely unaccustomed to (a feeling, experience, or situation).  
*He must have been a **stranger** to the village.*

**universe** All existing matter and space considered as a whole the cosmos The universe is believed to be at least 10 billion light years in diameter and contains a vast number of galaxies it has been expanding since its creation in the Big Bang about 13 billion years ago.  
*They study the evolution of the **universe**.*

**unrelated** Not connected by kinship.  
*Households containing two or more **unrelated** people.*
