*An enemy **alien**.*

extraterrestrial being A form of life assumed to exist outside the Earth or its atmosphere.



Extraterrestrial as an Adjective

Definitions of "Extraterrestrial" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "extraterrestrial" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Of or from outside the earth or its atmosphere.*
- *Originating or located or occurring outside Earth or its atmosphere.*



Synonyms of "Extraterrestrial" as an adjective (4 Words)

- alien** Not contained in or deriving from the essential nature of something.
***Alien** beings.*
- not of this world** Involving the entire earth; not limited or provincial in scope.
- preternatural** Existing outside of or not in accordance with nature-Aldous Huxley.
*Autumn had arrived with **preternatural** speed.*
- supernatural** (of a manifestation or event) attributed to some force beyond scientific understanding or the laws of nature.
*A woman of **supernatural** beauty.*



Usage Examples of "Extraterrestrial" as an adjective

- *Searches for extraterrestrial intelligence.*



Associations of "Extraterrestrial" (30 Words)

aerospace	The atmosphere and outer space considered as a whole.
alien	Transfer property or ownership. <i>Principles that are alien to them.</i>
astronaut	A person trained to travel in a spacecraft. <i>The Russians called their astronauts cosmonauts.</i>
blimp	A small airship or barrage balloon. <i>I could work out four hours a day and still end up a blimp.</i>
comet	(astronomy) a relatively small extraterrestrial body consisting of a frozen mass that travels around the sun in a highly elliptical orbit.
cosmic	Inconceivably vast. <i>The song is a masterpiece of cosmic proportions.</i>
dissimilar	Marked by dissimilarity. <i>A group of very dissimilar people.</i>
existential	Of or as conceived by existentialism. <i>Formal logicians are not concerned with existential matters.</i>

foreign	Dealing with or relating to other countries. <i>A visit to a foreign clan.</i>
foreigner	A piece of work done for private gain without an employer's permission or without declaration to the relevant authorities.
galaxy	The galaxy of which the solar system is a part the Milky Way. <i>Extragalactic nebula is a former name for galaxy.</i>
interstellar	Between or among stars. <i>Interstellar travel.</i>
lander	A spacecraft designed to land on the surface of a planet or moon. <i>A lunar lander.</i>
lunar	Of or relating to or associated with the moon. <i>A lunar eclipse.</i>
orbit	Of a celestial object or spacecraft move in orbit round a star or planet. <i>Mercury orbits the Sun.</i>
outsider	A person who does not belong to a particular organization or profession. <i>The winner was Beech Road a fifty to one outsider.</i>
paranormal	Seemingly outside normal sensory channels. <i>A mystic who can prove he has paranormal powers.</i>
planetary	Of or relating to or characteristic of the planet Earth or its inhabitants- L.C.Eiseley. <i>The laws of planetary motion.</i>
psychic	The study of psychic phenomena. <i>Psychic powers.</i>
saucer	A shallow dish, typically having a circular indentation in the centre, on which a cup is placed.
shuttle	Transport in a shuttle. <i>A shuttle bus departs every 30 minutes.</i>
space	Capacity for storage of data in a computer or other digital device. <i>They tested his ability to locate objects in space.</i>
spacecraft	A vehicle used for travelling in space.
spaceman	An astronaut.
spaceship	A spacecraft, especially one controlled by a crew.
star	Feature as the star. <i>The walls were painted with silver moons and stars.</i>
strange	Slightly or undefinably unwell or ill at ease. <i>What a strange sense of humor she has.</i>

stranger A person entirely unaccustomed to (a feeling, experience, or situation).
*He must have been a **stranger** to the village.*

universe All existing matter and space considered as a whole the cosmos The universe is believed to be at least 10 billion light years in diameter and contains a vast number of galaxies it has been expanding since its creation in the Big Bang about 13 billion years ago.
*They study the evolution of the **universe**.*

unrelated Not connected by kinship.
*Households containing two or more **unrelated** people.*
