- display** A performance, show, or event staged for public entertainment.
*The museum houses an informative **display** of rocks.*
- exhibition** A display or demonstration of a skill.
*Brasenose awarded him a senior Hulme **exhibition**.*
- pageant** A beauty contest.
*They brought the history books to life at the town's **pageant**.*
- performance** Any recognized accomplishment.
*Unit trust **performance**.*
- presentation** A visual representation of something.
*A sales **presentation**.*

- show** The act of publicly exhibiting or entertaining.
*They wanted to see some of the **shows** on Broadway.*
- spectacle** A blunder that makes you look ridiculous used in the phrase make a spectacle of yourself.
*The show is pure **spectacle**.*
- spectacular** An event such as a pageant or musical, produced on a large scale and with striking effects.
*They put on a Christmas **spectacular**.*
