## Synonyms of "Extravaganza" as a noun (8 Words)

<b>display</b>	A performance, show, or event staged for public entertainment. <i>The museum houses an informative <b>display</b> of rocks.</i>
<b>exhibition</b>	A display or demonstration of a skill. <i>Brasenose awarded him a senior Hulme <b>exhibition</b>.</i>
<b>pageant</b>	A beauty contest. <i>They brought the history books to life at the town's <b>pageant</b>.</i>
<b>performance</b>	Any recognized accomplishment. <i>Unit trust <b>performance</b>.</i>
<b>presentation</b>	A visual representation of something. <i>A sales <b>presentation</b>.</i>

**show**

The act of publicly exhibiting or entertaining.

*They wanted to see some of the **shows** on Broadway.*

**spectacle**

A blunder that makes you look ridiculous used in the phrase make a spectacle of yourself.

*The show is pure **spectacle**.*

**spectacular**

An event such as a pageant or musical, produced on a large scale and with striking effects.

*They put on a Christmas **spectacular**.*



**Usage Examples of "Extravaganza" as a noun**

- *An extravaganza of dance in many forms.*
