<a href="#">askance</a>	(used especially of glances) directed to one side with or as if with doubt or suspicion or envy. <i>The reformers looked <b>askance</b> at the mystical tradition.</i>
<a href="#">behold</a>	See with attention. <i>The botanical gardens were a wonder to <b>behold</b>.</i>
<a href="#">gaze</a>	A steady intent look. <i>He could only <b>gaze</b> at her in astonishment.</i>
<b>glance</b>	Throw a glance at take a brief look at. <i>Fish sporting with quick <b>glance</b> Show to the Sun their wav d coats.</i>
<b>leer</b>	Look suggestively or obliquely; look or gaze with a sly, immodest, or malign expression. <i>The men <b>leered</b> at the young women on the beach.</i>
<b>look</b>	Of a building or room have an outlook in a specified direction. <i>His camera does his <b>looking</b> for him.</i>
<b>observing</b>	Quick to notice; showing quick and keen perception.
<b>ocular</b>	Combination of lenses at the viewing end of optical instruments. <i>An <b>ocular</b> organ.</i>
<b>ophthalmologist</b>	A specialist in the branch of medicine concerned with the study and treatment of disorders and diseases of the eye.
<b>optic</b>	A lens or other optical component in an optical instrument. <i>The <b>optic</b> or <b>optical</b> axis of the eye.</i>
<b>optical</b>	Relating to or using sight. <i>An <b>optical</b> illusion.</i>
<b>optician</b>	A dispensing optician.
<a href="#">peek</a>	A secret look. <i>Faces <b>peeked</b> from behind twitched curtains.</i>

<b>perceptual</b>	Relating to the ability to interpret or become aware of something through the senses. <i>A patient with <b>perceptual</b> problems who cannot judge distances.</i>
<a href="#">see</a>	Go to see for a social visit. <i>The minister doesn't <b>see</b> anybody before noon.</i>
<b>seeing</b>	The action of seeing someone or something. <i>He had given the <b>seeing</b> as fair.</i>
<a href="#">sensory</a>	Relating to sensation or the physical senses; transmitted or perceived by the senses. <i><b>Sensory</b> neurons.</i>
<b>sidelong</b>	To or from one side; sideways. <i>He looked <b>sidelong</b> at her with a quick smile.</i>
<b>sight</b>	Catch sight of to perceive with the eyes. <i>We are all equal in the <b>sight</b> of God.</i>
<b>sightless</b>	Invisible. <i>Blank <b>sightless</b> eyes.</i>
<b>spectacle</b>	A blunder that makes you look ridiculous used in the phrase make a spectacle of yourself. <i>The <b>spectacle</b> of a city's mass grief.</i>
<b>squint</b>	Be cross eyed have a squint or strabismus. <i>The <b>squint</b> bottom edge of the puzzle.</i>
<a href="#">stare</a>	Look at with fixed eyes. <i>Her grey eyes <b>stared</b> back at him.</i>
<a href="#">staring</a>	Without qualification; used informally as (often pejorative) intensifiers. <i>Stark <b>staring</b> mad.</i>
<b>telescopic</b>	Having or consisting of concentric tubular sections designed to slide into one another. <i>A <b>telescopic</b> antenna.</i>
<a href="#">visible</a>	Visible imports or exports. <i>A <b>visible</b> supply.</i>
<b>vision</b>	The images seen on a television screen. <i>The idea came to him in a <b>vision</b>.</i>
<a href="#">visual</a>	Relating to seeing or sight. <i>A <b>visual</b> presentation.</i>
<a href="#">watch</a>	See or watch. <i>Lucy <b>watched</b> him go.</i>
