askance	(used especially of glances) directed to one side with or as if with doubt or suspicion or envy. <i>The reformers looked askance at the mystical tradition.</i>
behold	See with attention. <i>The botanical gardens were a wonder to behold.</i>
gaze	A steady intent look. <i>He could only gaze at her in astonishment.</i>
glance	Throw a glance at take a brief look at. <i>Fish sporting with quick glance Show to the Sun their wav d coats.</i>
leer	Look suggestively or obliquely; look or gaze with a sly, immodest, or malign expression. <i>The men leered at the young women on the beach.</i>
look	Of a building or room have an outlook in a specified direction. <i>His camera does his looking for him.</i>
observing	Quick to notice; showing quick and keen perception.
ocular	Combination of lenses at the viewing end of optical instruments. <i>An ocular organ.</i>
ophthalmologist	A specialist in the branch of medicine concerned with the study and treatment of disorders and diseases of the eye.
optic	A lens or other optical component in an optical instrument. <i>The optic or optical axis of the eye.</i>
optical	Relating to or using sight. <i>An optical illusion.</i>
optician	A dispensing optician.
peek	A secret look. <i>Faces peeked from behind twitched curtains.</i>

perceptual	Relating to the ability to interpret or become aware of something through the senses. <i>A patient with perceptual problems who cannot judge distances.</i>
see	Go to see for a social visit. <i>The minister doesn't see anybody before noon.</i>
seeing	The action of seeing someone or something. <i>He had given the seeing as fair.</i>
sensory	Relating to sensation or the physical senses; transmitted or perceived by the senses. <i>Sensory neurons.</i>
sidelong	To or from one side; sideways. <i>He looked sidelong at her with a quick smile.</i>
sight	Catch sight of to perceive with the eyes. <i>We are all equal in the sight of God.</i>
sightless	Invisible. <i>Blank sightless eyes.</i>
spectacle	A blunder that makes you look ridiculous used in the phrase make a spectacle of yourself. <i>The spectacle of a city's mass grief.</i>
squint	Be cross eyed have a squint or strabismus. <i>The squint bottom edge of the puzzle.</i>
stare	Look at with fixed eyes. <i>Her grey eyes stared back at him.</i>
staring	Without qualification; used informally as (often pejorative) intensifiers. <i>Stark staring mad.</i>
telescopic	Having or consisting of concentric tubular sections designed to slide into one another. <i>A telescopic antenna.</i>
visible	Visible imports or exports. <i>A visible supply.</i>
vision	The images seen on a television screen. <i>The idea came to him in a vision.</i>
visual	Relating to seeing or sight. <i>A visual presentation.</i>
watch	See or watch. <i>Lucy watched him go.</i>
