- *Artifact made by weaving or felting or knitting or crocheting natural or synthetic fibers.*
- *The walls, floor, and roof of a building.*

[anatomy](#)

The branch of science concerned with the bodily structure of humans, animals, and other living organisms, especially as revealed by dissection and the separation of parts.

*Human **anatomy**.*

cloth

A piece of cloth for cleaning or covering something e.g a dishcloth or a tablecloth.

*A **cloth** bag.*

[composition](#)

A musical work that has been created.

*The social **composition** of villages.*

[constitution](#)

The constitution written at the Constitutional Convention in Philadelphia in 1787 and subsequently ratified by the original thirteen states.

*The **constitution** of a police authority.*

construction

The action of building something, typically a large structure.

*They put an unsympathetic **construction** on his conduct.*

essence	A property or group of properties of something without which it would not exist or be what it is. <i>Locke s scepticism about our ability to penetrate to the real essences of things.</i>
form	A set order of words a formula. <i>He was at the top of his form.</i>
foundations	Lowest support of a structure. <i>There is little foundation for his objections.</i>
<u>frame</u>	The framework for a pair of eyeglasses. <i>The frame of verbs of perception.</i>
framework	A structure supporting or containing something. <i>The theoretical framework of political sociology.</i>
infrastructure	The stock of basic facilities and capital equipment needed for the functioning of a country or area. <i>The social and economic infrastructure of a country.</i>
make-up	Cosmetics applied to the face to improve or change your appearance.
material	Artifact made by weaving or felting or knitting or crocheting natural or synthetic fibers. <i>He s not really Olympic material.</i>
<u>mechanisms</u>	Device consisting of a piece of machinery; has moving parts that perform some function. <i>He determined unique mechanisms for the photochemical reactions.</i>
organization	The action of organizing something. <i>The facts were familiar but it was in the organization of them that he was original.</i>
structure	The arrangement of and relations between the parts or elements of something complex. <i>Artists must study the structure of the human body.</i>
stuff	Unspecified qualities required to do or be something. <i>Don t give me that stuff.</i>
<u>textile</u>	Artifact made by weaving or felting or knitting or crocheting natural or synthetic fibers. <i>A fascinating range of pottery jewellery and textiles.</i>
tissue	Tissue paper. <i>Rosheen wiped her fingers on a sheet of tissue.</i>
<u>web</u>	The flattened weblike part of a feather consisting of a series of barbs on either side of the shaft. <i>Web publishing.</i>

- baize** A bright green fabric napped to resemble felt; used to cover gaming tables.
- bleach** The act of whitening something by bleaching it exposing it to sunlight or using a chemical bleaching agent.
*The sun **bleached** the red shirt.*
- canvas** An oil painting on canvas fabric.
*They found a **canvas** and he seated his model.*
- carpet** Cover with carpet.
*The New York **carpet** courts.*
- cloak** A cloakroom.
*Preparations had taken place under a **cloak** of secrecy.*
- cloth** A piece of cloth for cleaning or covering something e g a dishcloth or a tablecloth.
*Wipe clean with a damp **cloth**.*

cotton	Fabric woven from cotton fibers. <i>A cotton reel.</i>
curtain	A raising or lowering of the curtain at the beginning or end of an act or scene. <i>The art is to hold your audience right from the opening curtain.</i>
doff	Remove. <i>He doffed his hat.</i>
<u>drape</u>	Arrange (cloth or clothing) loosely or casually on or round something. <i>The body was draped in a blanket.</i>
drapery	The depiction of folds of cloth in sculpture or painting. <i>The hall of the school was hung with green drapery.</i>
felt	Change texture so as to become matted and felt like. <i>A felt hat.</i>
flax	Fiber of the flax plant that is made into thread and woven into linen fabric. <i>A mill for the preparation and spinning of flax.</i>
laundry	A room in a house, hotel, or institution where clothes and linen can be washed and ironed. <i>Lots of people send their sheets to a laundry these days.</i>
leather	Leather clothes especially those worn by a motorcyclist. <i>He caught me and leathered me black and blue.</i>
linen	A high quality paper made of linen fibers or with a linen finish. <i>A linen suit.</i>
lining	The act of attaching an inside lining to a garment or curtain etc. <i>Self clean oven linings.</i>
loincloth	A single piece of cloth wrapped round the hips, typically worn by men in some hot countries as their only garment.
mohair	A yarn or fabric made from mohair typically mixed with wool. <i>A mohair sweater.</i>
nylon	Stockings or tights made of nylon. <i>The tent is made of blue nylon.</i>
plush	A fabric with a nap that is longer and softer than velvet. <i>A plush Mayfair flat.</i>
quilted	Made of layers of fabric held together by patterned stitching. <i>A blue quilted jacket.</i>
sheet	Cover with or wrap in a sheet of cloth. <i>A sheet of ice.</i>
<u>textile</u>	Used by nudists in reference to non-nudists. <i>Textile beaches.</i>

thread Pass a thread through.
*He had a loose **thread** on his shirt.*

upholstery The craft of upholstering.
*Leather **upholstery**.*

valance A length of decorative drapery attached to the canopy or frame of a bed in order to screen the structure or the space beneath it.

vinyl Vinyl used as the standard material for records.
*He had plenty of tapes and **vinyls**.*

wool Yarn or textile fibre made from wool.
*Carpets made of 80 per cent **wool** and 20 per cent nylon.*

yarn Tell or spin a yarn.
*Hanks of pale green **yarn**.*
