

**leather** Leather clothes especially those worn by a motorcyclist.

lining The act of attaching an inside lining to a garment or curtain etc.

loincloth A single piece of cloth wrapped round the hips, typically worn by men in some

mohair A yarn or fabric made from mohair typically mixed with wool.

**nylon** Stockings or tights made of nylon.

**plush** A fabric with a nap that is longer and softer than velvet.

A **plush** Mayfair flat.

**quilted** Made of layers of fabric held together by patterned stitching.

A blue **quilted** jacket.

**sheet** Cover with or wrap in a sheet of cloth.

A **sheet** of ice.

**textile** Used by nudists in reference to non-nudists.

**Textile** beaches.



thread Pass a thread through.

He had a loose **thread** on his shirt.

valance A length of decorative drapery attached to the canopy or frame of a bed in
