<b>framework</b>	<p>A structure supporting or containing something.</p> <p><i>The theoretical <b>framework</b> of political sociology.</i></p>
<b>infrastructure</b>	<p>The stock of basic facilities and capital equipment needed for the functioning of a country or area.</p> <p><i>The social and economic <b>infrastructure</b> of a country.</i></p>
<b>make-up</b>	<p>Cosmetics applied to the face to improve or change your appearance.</p>
<b>material</b>	<p>Artifact made by weaving or felting or knitting or crocheting natural or synthetic fibers.</p> <p><i>He s not really Olympic <b>material</b>.</i></p>
<a href="#"><u>mechanisms</u></a>	<p>Device consisting of a piece of machinery; has moving parts that perform some function.</p> <p><i>He determined unique <b>mechanisms</b> for the photochemical reactions.</i></p>
<b>organization</b>	<p>The action of organizing something.</p> <p><i>The facts were familiar but it was in the <b>organization</b> of them that he was original.</i></p>
<b>structure</b>	<p>The arrangement of and relations between the parts or elements of something complex.</p> <p><i>Artists must study the <b>structure</b> of the human body.</i></p>
<b>stuff</b>	<p>Unspecified qualities required to do or be something.</p> <p><i>Don t give me that <b>stuff</b>.</i></p>
<a href="#"><u>textile</u></a>	<p>Artifact made by weaving or felting or knitting or crocheting natural or synthetic fibers.</p> <p><i>A fascinating range of pottery jewellery and <b>textiles</b>.</i></p>
<b>tissue</b>	<p>Tissue paper.</p> <p><i>Rosheen wiped her fingers on a sheet of <b>tissue</b>.</i></p>

- baize** A bright green fabric napped to resemble felt; used to cover gaming tables.
- bleach** The act of whitening something by bleaching it exposing it to sunlight or using a chemical bleaching agent.  
*The sun **bleached** the red shirt.*
- canvas** An oil painting on canvas fabric.  
*They found a **canvas** and he seated his model.*
- carpet** Cover with carpet.  
*The New York **carpet** courts.*
- cloak** A cloakroom.  
*Preparations had taken place under a **cloak** of secrecy.*
- cloth** A piece of cloth for cleaning or covering something e g a dishcloth or a tablecloth.  
*Wipe clean with a damp **cloth**.*

<b>cotton</b>	Fabric woven from cotton fibers. <i>A <b>cotton</b> reel.</i>
<b>curtain</b>	A raising or lowering of the curtain at the beginning or end of an act or scene. <i>The art is to hold your audience right from the opening <b>curtain</b>.</i>
<b>doff</b>	Remove. <i>He <b>doffed</b> his hat.</i>
<b>drape</b>	Arrange (cloth or clothing) loosely or casually on or round something. <i>The body was <b>draped</b> in a blanket.</i>
<b>drapery</b>	The depiction of folds of cloth in sculpture or painting. <i>The hall of the school was hung with green <b>drapery</b>.</i>
<b>felt</b>	Change texture so as to become matted and felt like. <i>A <b>felt</b> hat.</i>
<b>flax</b>	Fiber of the flax plant that is made into thread and woven into linen fabric. <i>A mill for the preparation and spinning of <b>flax</b>.</i>
<b>laundry</b>	A room in a house, hotel, or institution where clothes and linen can be washed and ironed. <i>Lots of people send their sheets to a <b>laundry</b> these days.</i>
<b>leather</b>	Leather clothes especially those worn by a motorcyclist. <i>He caught me and <b>leathered</b> me black and blue.</i>
<b>linen</b>	A high quality paper made of linen fibers or with a linen finish. <i>A <b>linen</b> suit.</i>
<b>lining</b>	The act of attaching an inside lining to a garment or curtain etc. <i>Self clean oven <b>linings</b>.</i>
<b>loincloth</b>	A single piece of cloth wrapped round the hips, typically worn by men in some hot countries as their only garment.
<b>mohair</b>	A yarn or fabric made from mohair typically mixed with wool. <i>A <b>mohair</b> sweater.</i>
<b>nylon</b>	Stockings or tights made of nylon. <i>The tent is made of blue <b>nylon</b>.</i>
<b>plush</b>	A fabric with a nap that is longer and softer than velvet. <i>A <b>plush</b> Mayfair flat.</i>
<b>quilted</b>	Made of layers of fabric held together by patterned stitching. <i>A blue <b>quilted</b> jacket.</i>
<b>sheet</b>	Cover with or wrap in a sheet of cloth. <i>A <b>sheet</b> of ice.</i>
<b>textile</b>	Used by nudists in reference to non-nudists. <i><b>Textile</b> beaches.</i>

**thread**

Pass a thread through.  
*He had a loose **thread** on his shirt.*

**upholstery**

The craft of upholstering.  
*Leather **upholstery**.*

**valance**

A length of decorative drapery attached to the canopy or frame of a bed in order to screen the structure or the space beneath it.

**vinyl**

Vinyl used as the standard material for records.  
*He had plenty of tapes and **vinyls**.*

**wool**

Yarn or textile fibre made from wool.  
*Carpets made of 80 per cent **wool** and 20 per cent nylon.*

**yarn**

Tell or spin a yarn.  
*Hanks of pale green **yarn**.*
