aquiline	Like an eagle.
<u>brighten</u>	Make (something) more attractively colourful. Most of the country should <b>brighten</b> up later.
careworn	Tired and unhappy because of prolonged worry. Looking <b>careworn</b> as she bent over her mending.
complexion	A point of view or general attitude or inclination. <i>He altered the <b>complexion</b> of his times.</i>
<u>countenance</u>	Admit as acceptable or possible. A pleasant <b>countenance</b> .
drawn	(of a person) looking strained from illness, exhaustion, anxiety, or pain. Her face was <b>drawn</b> and haggard from sleeplessness.
encounter	A violent incident in which a suspected criminal is killed by a member of the police, especially under controversial circumstances. <i>She felt totally unnerved by the <b>encounter</b>.</i>
eyebrow	The strip of hair growing on the ridge above a person's eye socket. <i>He had eyes of blue beneath bushy <b>eyebrow</b>s.</i>
freckle	Become freckled. She had a light sprinkling of <b>freckle</b> s on her nose.
<u>frown</u>	Furrow one's brows in an expression indicating disapproval, displeasure, or concentration. <i>He</i> <b>frown</b> ed as he reread the letter.
<u>glare</u>	Shine intensely. The moon <b>glare</b> d back at itself from the lake s surface.
glower	Have an angry or sullen look on one's face; scowl. She <b>glower</b> ed at him suspiciously.
ineluctable	Unable to be resisted or avoided; inescapable. An <b>ineluctable</b> destiny.



mien	Dignified manner or conduct. <i>He has a cautious academic <b>mien</b>.</i>
nasal	A nasal speech sound. A drawling <b>nasal</b> voice.
nose	Push or move with the nose. A dog with a keen <b>nose</b> .
olfaction	The faculty that enables us to distinguish scents.
<u>pale</u>	Turn pale as if in fear. The late afternoon light coming through the el tracks fell in <b>pale</b> oblongs on the street.
pallid	Abnormally deficient in color as suggesting physical or emotional distress. <b>Pallid</b> liberalism.
pallor	An unhealthy pale appearance. The deathlike <b>pallor</b> of his face.
proboscis	(in some worms) an extensible tubular sucking organ.
sallow	Cause to become sallow. <i>Sallow faced addicts.</i>
<u>scowl</u>	Frown with displeasure. She stamped into the room with a <b>scowl</b> on her face.
shrug	An act or instance of shrugging one s shoulders. She lifted her shoulders in a dismissive <b>shrug</b> .
sinus	A wide channel containing blood; does not have the coating of an ordinary blood vessel. <i>Sinus tachycardia</i> .
smiley	A symbol representing a smiling face that is used in written communication to indicate that the writer is pleased or joking. <i>He drew a smiley face.</i>
subtend	(of a line, arc, or figure) form (an angle) at a particular point when straight lines from its extremities are joined at that point. <i>The main beauty is provided by the bracts which</i> <b>subtend</b> <i>the flowers.</i>
swarthy	Dark-complexioned. <i>Swarthy</i> men with gleaming teeth.
<u>visage</u>	The manifestation, image, or aspect of something. An elegant angular <b>visage</b> .
<u>wan</u>	(of a smile) lacking enthusiasm or energy. She was looking <b>wan</b> and bleary eyed.
