Associations of "Face to face" (30 Words)

aquiline	Like an eagle.
brighten	Make (something) more attractively colourful. <i>Most of the country should brighten up later.</i>
careworn	Tired and unhappy because of prolonged worry. <i>Looking careworn as she bent over her mending.</i>
complexion	A point of view or general attitude or inclination. <i>He altered the complexion of his times.</i>
countenance	Admit as acceptable or possible. <i>A pleasant countenance.</i>
drawn	(of a person) looking strained from illness, exhaustion, anxiety, or pain. <i>Her face was drawn and haggard from sleeplessness.</i>
encounter	A violent incident in which a suspected criminal is killed by a member of the police, especially under controversial circumstances. <i>She felt totally unnerved by the encounter.</i>
eyebrow	The strip of hair growing on the ridge above a person’s eye socket. <i>He had eyes of blue beneath bushy eyebrows.</i>
freckle	Become freckled. <i>She had a light sprinkling of freckles on her nose.</i>
frown	Furrow one’s brows in an expression indicating disapproval, displeasure, or concentration. <i>He frowned as he reread the letter.</i>
glare	Shine intensely. <i>The moon glared back at itself from the lake s surface.</i>
glower	Have an angry or sullen look on one’s face; scowl. <i>She glowered at him suspiciously.</i>
ineluctable	Unable to be resisted or avoided; inescapable. <i>An ineluctable destiny.</i>

mien	Dignified manner or conduct. <i>He has a cautious academic mien.</i>
nasal	A nasal speech sound. <i>A drawling nasal voice.</i>
nose	Push or move with the nose. <i>A dog with a keen nose.</i>
olfaction	The faculty that enables us to distinguish scents.
pale	Turn pale as if in fear. <i>The late afternoon light coming through the el tracks fell in pale oblongs on the street.</i>
pallid	Abnormally deficient in color as suggesting physical or emotional distress. <i>Pallid liberalism.</i>
pallor	An unhealthy pale appearance. <i>The deathlike pallor of his face.</i>
proboscis	(in some worms) an extensible tubular sucking organ.
sallow	Cause to become sallow. <i>Sallow faced addicts.</i>
scowl	Frown with displeasure. <i>She stamped into the room with a scowl on her face.</i>
shrug	An act or instance of shrugging one's shoulders. <i>She lifted her shoulders in a dismissive shrug.</i>
sinus	A wide channel containing blood; does not have the coating of an ordinary blood vessel. <i>Sinus tachycardia.</i>
smiley	A symbol representing a smiling face that is used in written communication to indicate that the writer is pleased or joking. <i>He drew a smiley face.</i>
subtend	(of a line, arc, or figure) form (an angle) at a particular point when straight lines from its extremities are joined at that point. <i>The main beauty is provided by the bracts which subtend the flowers.</i>
swarthy	Dark-complexioned. <i>Swarthy men with gleaming teeth.</i>
visage	The manifestation, image, or aspect of something. <i>An elegant angular visage.</i>
wan	(of a smile) lacking enthusiasm or energy. <i>She was looking wan and bleary eyed.</i>
