<b>bigamist</b>	Someone who marries one person while already legally married to another.

<b>bridal</b>	Archaic terms for a wedding or wedding feast. <i>Her white <b>bridal</b> gown.</i>
<b><a href="#">concubine</a></b>	A woman who cohabits with an important man.
<b>conjoin</b>	Take in marriage. <i>An approach which <b>conjoins</b> theory and method.</i>
<b><a href="#">couple</a></b>	Two people or things of the same sort considered together. <i>Can we <b>couple</b> these proposals.</i>
<b>ex</b>	Out of fashion. <i>All his <b>exes</b> live in Texas.</i>
<b>fiancee</b>	A woman who is engaged to be married.
<b><a href="#">girlfriend</a></b>	Any female friend. <i>She would rather go to the cinema with a <b>girlfriend</b>.</i>
<b>harridan</b>	A scolding (even vicious) old woman. <i>A bullying old <b>harridan</b>.</i>
<b>heterosexual</b>	A heterosexual person. <i><b>Heterosexual</b> relationships.</i>
<b>honeymoon</b>	Spend a honeymoon. <i>The new President's <b>honeymoon</b> period.</i>
<b><a href="#">husband</a></b>	A married man; a woman's partner in marriage. <i>She and her <b>husband</b> are both retired.</i>

<b><u>lover</u></b>	An ardent follower and admirer. <i>Music <b>lovers</b>.</i>
<b>marital</b>	Of or relating to the state of marriage. <i><b>Marital</b> fidelity.</i>
<b>marriage</b>	The legally or formally recognized union of two people as partners in a personal relationship (historically and in some jurisdictions specifically a union between a man and a woman). <i>A <b>marriage</b> of ideas.</i>
<b>married</b>	Married people. <i>We were young <b>marrieds</b> during World War Two.</i>
<b>marry</b>	Enter into marriage. <i>Most Chardonnays don t <b>marry</b> well with salmon.</i>
<b>mistress</b>	A woman master who directs the work of others. <i>A Geography <b>mistress</b>.</i>
<b>newlywed</b>	Someone recently married.
<b><u>paramour</u></b>	A lover, especially the illicit partner of a married person.
<b><u>partner</u></b>	Be the partner of. <i>A junior <b>partner</b>.</i>
<b>wed</b>	Perform a marriage ceremony. <i>Will you <b>wed</b> your daughter to him.</i>
<b>widow</b>	Become a widow or widower lose one s spouse through death. <i>She had to care for her <b>widowed</b> mother.</i>
<b>widower</b>	A man whose spouse is often away participating in a specified sport or activity. <i>Her new found passion has turned me into a tennis <b>widower</b>.</i>
<b><u>wife</u></b>	The wife of a person with a specified occupation. <i>A clergy <b>wife</b>.</i>
