| fiancee | A woman who is engaged to be married. |
| girlfriend | Any female friend. <i>She would rather go to the cinema with a girlfriend.</i> |
| harridan | A scolding (even vicious) old woman. <i>A bullying old harridan.</i> |
| heterosexual | A heterosexual person. <i>Heterosexual relationships.</i> |
| honeymoon | Spend a honeymoon. <i>The new President's honeymoon period.</i> |
| husband | A married man; a woman's partner in marriage. <i>She and her husband are both retired.</i> |

| lover | An ardent follower and admirer. <i>Music lovers.</i> |
| marital | Of or relating to the state of marriage. <i>Marital fidelity.</i> |
| marriage | The legally or formally recognized union of two people as partners in a personal relationship (historically and in some jurisdictions specifically a union between a man and a woman). <i>A marriage of ideas.</i> |
| married | Married people. <i>We were young marrieds during World War Two.</i> |
| marry | Enter into marriage. <i>Most Chardonnays don t marry well with salmon.</i> |
| mistress | A woman master who directs the work of others. <i>A Geography mistress.</i> |
| newlywed | Someone recently married. |
| paramour | A lover, especially the illicit partner of a married person. |
| partner | Be the partner of. <i>A junior partner.</i> |
| wed | Perform a marriage ceremony. <i>Will you wed your daughter to him.</i> |
| widow | Become a widow or widower lose one s spouse through death. <i>She had to care for her widowed mother.</i> |
