## **The Forms of Fall**

Infinitive	<b>to fall</b>
Present Tense	<b>fall / falls</b>
Past Tense	<b>fell or ( in archaic sense only ) felled</b>
Present Participle	<b>falling</b>
Past Participle	<b>fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled</b>

## **Conjugate Fall**

### **Fall in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>fall</b>	We <b>fall</b>
You <b>fall</b>	You <b>fall</b>
He/She/It <b>falls</b>	They <b>fall</b>

### **Fall in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am falling</b>	We <b>are falling</b>
You <b>are falling</b>	You <b>are falling</b>
He/She/It <b>is falling</b>	They <b>are falling</b>

### **Fall in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled</b>	We <b>have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled</b>
You <b>have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled</b>	You <b>have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled</b>
He/She/It <b>has fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled</b>	They <b>have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled</b>

### **Fall in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been falling</b>	We <b>have been falling</b>
You <b>have been falling</b>	You <b>have been falling</b>
He/She/It <b>has been falling</b>	They <b>have been falling</b>

### **Fall in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>fell or ( in archaic sense only ) felled</b>	We <b>fell or ( in archaic sense only ) felled</b>
You <b>fell or ( in archaic sense only ) felled</b>	You <b>fell or ( in archaic sense only ) felled</b>

**Singular**

He/She/It **fell or ( in archaic sense only )  
felled**

**Plural**

They **fell or ( in archaic sense only )  
felled**

**Fall in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

I **was falling**

You **were falling**

He/She/It **was falling**

**Plural**

We **were falling**

You **were falling**

They **were falling**

**Fall in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

I **had fallen or (in archaic sense only)  
felled**

You **had fallen or (in archaic sense only)  
felled**

He/She/It **had fallen or (in archaic sense  
only) felled**

**Plural**

We **had fallen or (in archaic sense only)  
felled**

You **had fallen or (in archaic sense only)  
felled**

They **had fallen or (in archaic sense  
only) felled**

**Fall in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

I **had been falling**

You **had been falling**

He/She/It **had been falling**

**Plural**

We **had been falling**

You **had been falling**

They **had been falling**

**Fall in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

I **will fall**

You **will fall**

He/She/It **will fall**

**Plural**

We **will fall**

You **will fall**

They **will fall**

## **Fall in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will be falling**

**You will be falling**

**He/She/It will be falling**

### **Plural**

**We will be falling**

**You will be falling**

**They will be falling**

## **Fall in Future Perfect Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled**

**You will have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled**

**He/She/It will have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled**

### **Plural**

**We will have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled**

**You will have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled**

**They will have fallen or (in archaic sense only) felled**

## **Fall in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

### **Singular**

**I will have been falling**

**You will have been falling**

**He/She/It will have been falling**

### **Plural**

**We will have been falling**

**You will have been falling**

**They will have been falling**
