Definitions of "Fallout" as a noun

- Airborne substances resulting from an industrial process or accident.
- Any adverse and unwanted secondary effect.
- The radioactive particles that settle to the ground after a nuclear explosion.
- The adverse results of a situation or action.
- Radioactive particles that are carried into the atmosphere after a nuclear explosion and gradually fall back as dust or in precipitation.





Synonyms of "Fallout" as a noun (11 Words)

backwashA backward current created by an object moving through water or air.

The **backwash** of the Cuban missile crisis.

by-product A secondary and sometimes unexpected consequence.

A return to fashion of an item, activity, or style.

Trouser suits are making a**comeback**.

An inference that follows directly from the proof of another proposition.

corollary The huge increases in unemployment were the **corollary** of expenditure

cuts.

counteraction Action intended to nullify the effects of some previous action.

counterblast A vigorous and unrestrained response.

A **counterblast** to the growing propaganda of the Left.



recoil The action of recoiling.

His body jerked with the recoil of the rifle.

repercussions A movement back from an impact.

His declaration had unforeseen **repercussions**.

side effect An opinion that is held in opposition to another in an argument or dispute.

A trailer for a film or broadcast.

Police followed his **trail** to Dorset.

wake (especially in Ireland) a party held after a funeral.

His workers absented themselves for the local wakes.



Usage Examples of "Fallout" as a noun

- He's prepared to take calculated risks regardless of political fallout.
- A fallout shelter.
- A strategy to contain the fallout from the accounting scandal.
- Acid fallout from power stations.
