<a href="#">apart</a>	Having characteristics not shared by others- Vannever Bush. <i>Studies from as far <b>apart</b> as America and Iceland.</i>
<b>area</b>	A particular environment or walk of life. <i>The room is twelve square feet in <b>area</b>.</i>
<a href="#">arrival</a>	A person who has arrived somewhere. <i>Ruth s <b>arrival</b> in New York.</i>
<a href="#">astray</a>	Far from the intended target. <i>A bullet went <b>astray</b> and killed a bystander.</i>
<a href="#">away</a>	Out of the way especially away from one s thoughts. <i>The wedding is only weeks <b>away</b>.</i>
<a href="#">constellation</a>	A configuration of stars as seen from the earth. <i>No two patients ever show exactly the same <b>constellation</b> of symptoms.</i>
<b>distal</b>	Situated farthest from point of attachment or origin, as of a limb or bone. <i>The <b>distal</b> end of the tibia.</i>
<a href="#">distant</a>	(after a measurement) at a specified distance. <i>The star is 30 000 light years <b>distant</b> from Earth.</i>
<b>eventually</b>	In the end, especially after a long delay, dispute, or series of problems. <i><b>Eventually</b> after midnight I arrived at the hotel.</i>
<a href="#">expanse</a>	A wide and open space or area as of surface or land or sky. <i>The moth has a wing <b>expanse</b> of 20 to 24 mm.</i>
<b>farther</b>	To or at a greater extent or degree or a more advanced stage further is used more often than farther in this abstract sense. <i><b>Farther</b> from our expectations.</i>
<a href="#">finally</a>	In such a way as to put an end to doubt and dispute. <i><b>Finally</b> it is common knowledge that travel broadens the horizons.</i>
<b>forth</b>	From a particular thing or place or position forth is obsolete. <i>Go <b>forth</b> and preach.</i>

<b>further</b>	To or at a greater extent or degree or a more advanced stage further is used more often than farther in this abstract sense. <i>Wages have been driven down even <b>further</b>.</i>
<b>galaxy</b>	The galaxy of which the solar system is a part the Milky Way. <i>Extragalactic nebula is a former name for <b>galaxy</b>.</i>
<b>inaccessible</b>	(of a person) not open to advances or influence; unapproachable. <i>The city centre is <b>inaccessible</b> to traffic in most places.</i>
<b>isle</b>	An island or peninsula, especially a small one. <i>Crusoe s fabled <b>isle</b>.</i>
<b>location</b>	A position or address in computer memory. <i>They shot the film on <b>location</b> in Nevada.</i>
<b>mile</b>	A former British unit of length equivalent to 6 080 feet 1 853 184 meters 800 feet longer than a statute mile. <i>He missed by a <b>mile</b>.</i>
<b>outback</b>	Any remote or sparsely populated inland region. <i>The <b>outback</b> of Ontario.</i>
<b>outlying</b>	Relatively far from a center or middle. <i><b>Outlying</b> settlements.</i>
<b>outpost</b>	A military post stationed at a distance from the main body of troops. <i>A few scattered <b>outposts</b> along the west coast.</i>
<b>remote</b>	A remote control device. <i>A second feature allows pagers to be alerted from <b>remote</b> alarm sensors.</i>
<b>scope</b>	A telescope microscope or other device having a name ending in scope. <i>They d <b>scoped</b> out their market.</i>
<b>secluded</b>	(of a place) not seen or visited by many people; sheltered and private. <i>A <b>secluded</b> romantic spot.</i>
<b>solitary</b>	Single; only. <i>Tigers are essentially <b>solitary</b>.</i>
<b>stray</b>	A stray person or thing especially a domestic animal. <i>Dog owners are urged not to allow their dogs to <b>stray</b>.</i>
<b>ultimately</b>	Finally; in the end. <i>The largest firms may <b>ultimately</b> become unstoppable.</i>
<b>underpopulated</b>	Having a lower population density than normal or desirable. <i>The richly endowed but <b>underpopulated</b> Ivory Coast.</i>
<b>yon</b>	At or in an indicated usually distant place yon is archaic and dialectal. <i>Scattered here and <b>yon</b>.</i>
