- audacious** Unrestrained by convention or propriety.  
*A series of **audacious** takeovers.*
- bold** (especially of a child) naughty; badly behaved.  
*She tossed him a **bold** look.*
- brave** Brightly colored and showy.  
*Girls decked out in **brave** new dresses.*
- confident** Feeling or showing confidence in oneself or one's abilities or qualities.  
*A **confident** speaker.*
- courageous** Not deterred by danger or pain; brave.  
*A frank **courageous** heart triumphed over pain.*
- daring** (of a person or action) adventurous or audaciously bold.  
*He rapidly discovered an audience hungry for his **daring** new works.*
- dauntless** Invulnerable to fear or intimidation.  
***Dauntless** bravery.*

<b>doughty</b>	Brave and persistent. <i>His <b>doughty</b> spirit kept him going.</i>
<b>dynamic</b>	Of or relating to dynamics. <i>The <b>dynamic</b> content of these sites keeps their audience informed and up to date.</i>
<b><u>gallant</u></b>	Having or displaying great dignity or nobility. <i>Put up a <b>gallant</b> resistance to the attackers.</i>
<b>hardy</b>	Capable of enduring difficult conditions; robust. <i>A <b>hardy</b> breed of cattle.</i>
<b><u>heroic</u></b>	Relating to or characteristic of heroes of antiquity. <i>One passes under pyramids and obelisks all on a <b>heroic</b> scale.</i>
<b>indomitable</b>	Impossible to subdue or defeat. <i>A woman of <b>indomitable</b> spirit.</i>
<b><u>intrepid</u></b>	Invulnerable to fear or intimidation. <i><b>Intrepid</b> pioneers.</i>
<b>lionhearted</b>	Extraordinarily courageous. <i>A brilliant <b>lionhearted</b> second half comeback.</i>
<b>mettlesome</b>	Having a proud and unbroken spirit. <i>Their horses were beasts of burden not <b>mettlesome</b> chargers.</i>
<b>plucky</b>	Showing courage. <i>The <b>plucky</b> youngster has astounded medical staff.</i>
<b><u>spirited</u></b>	Made lively or spirited. <i>A warm hearted generous <b>spirited</b> man.</i>
<b><u>unafraid</u></b>	Oblivious of dangers or perils or calmly resolute in facing them. <i>She was calm and <b>unafraid</b>.</i>
<b>unfearing</b>	Invulnerable to fear or intimidation.
<b><u>valiant</u></b>	Having or showing valor. <i>A <b>valiant</b> soldier.</i>
<b>valorous</b>	Having or showing valor. <i><b>Valorous</b> deeds on the field of honour.</i>
