audacious	Unrestrained by convention or propriety. <i>A series of audacious takeovers.</i>
bold	(especially of a child) naughty; badly behaved. <i>She tossed him a bold look.</i>
<u>brave</u>	Brightly colored and showy. <i>Girls decked out in brave new dresses.</i>
confident	Feeling or showing confidence in oneself or one's abilities or qualities. <i>A confident speaker.</i>
courageous	Not deterred by danger or pain; brave. <i>A frank courageous heart triumphed over pain.</i>
daring	(of a person or action) adventurous or audaciously bold. <i>He rapidly discovered an audience hungry for his daring new works.</i>
dauntless	Invulnerable to fear or intimidation. <i>Dauntless bravery.</i>

doughty	Brave and persistent. <i>His doughty spirit kept him going.</i>
dynamic	Of or relating to dynamics. <i>The dynamic content of these sites keeps their audience informed and up to date.</i>
<u>gallant</u>	Having or displaying great dignity or nobility. <i>Put up a gallant resistance to the attackers.</i>
hardy	Capable of enduring difficult conditions; robust. <i>A hardy breed of cattle.</i>
<u>heroic</u>	Relating to or characteristic of heroes of antiquity. <i>One passes under pyramids and obelisks all on a heroic scale.</i>
indomitable	Impossible to subdue or defeat. <i>A woman of indomitable spirit.</i>
<u>intrepid</u>	Invulnerable to fear or intimidation. <i>Intrepid pioneers.</i>
lionhearted	Extraordinarily courageous. <i>A brilliant lionhearted second half comeback.</i>
mettlesome	Having a proud and unbroken spirit. <i>Their horses were beasts of burden not mettlesome chargers.</i>
plucky	Showing courage. <i>The plucky youngster has astounded medical staff.</i>
<u>spirited</u>	Made lively or spirited. <i>A warm hearted generous spirited man.</i>
<u>unafraid</u>	Oblivious of dangers or perils or calmly resolute in facing them. <i>She was calm and unafraid.</i>
unfearing	Invulnerable to fear or intimidation.
<u>valiant</u>	Having or showing valor. <i>A valiant soldier.</i>
valorous	Having or showing valor. <i>Valorous deeds on the field of honour.</i>
