## Synonyms of "Feces" as a noun (7 Words)

- bm** Solid excretory product evacuated from the bowels.
- dejection** A sad and depressed state; low spirits.  
*He was slumped in deep **dejection**.*
- faecal matter** A vaguely specified concern.
- faeces** Waste matter remaining after food has been digested, discharged from the bowels; excrement.
- fecal matter** Some situation or event that is thought about.
- ordure** Something regarded as vile or abhorrent.  
*Can you give credence to this **ordure**.*
- stool** Solid excretory product evacuated from the bowels.  
*Fibre in the child s diet will soften the **stools**.*



## Associations of "Feces" (30 Words)

- aft** Situated at near or towards the stern of a ship or tail of an aircraft.  
*Ships with square sails sail fairly efficiently with the wind **abaft**.*
- bulkhead** A dividing wall or barrier between separate compartments inside a ship, aircraft, or other vehicle.
- compost** Make vegetable matter or manure into compost.  
*Cover with a layer of fine **compost**.*
- deck** A set of two or more record decks connected to sound mixing equipment used by a DJ.  
*Sitting on his **deck** on that sunny Sunday afternoon.*
- digest** A substance or mixture obtained by digestion.  
*I cannot **digest** all this information.*

<b>digestion</b>	The process of decomposing organic matter (as in sewage) by bacteria or by chemical action or heat. <i>He suffered with his <b>digestion</b>.</i>
<b>dung</b>	Drop or spread dung on a piece of ground. <i>You must <b>dung</b> the land.</i>
<b>eliminate</b>	Eliminate from the body. <i>The police have <b>eliminated</b> Lawrence from their inquiries.</i>
<b>evacuation</b>	The bodily process of discharging waste matter. <i>There were waves of <b>evacuation</b> during the blitz.</i>
<b>excrement</b>	Waste matter discharged from the bowels; faeces.
<a href="#">excrete</a>	Eliminate from the body. <i>Excess bicarbonate is <b>excreted</b> by the kidney.</i>
<b>excretion</b>	(in living organisms and cells) the process of eliminating or expelling waste matter. <i>Bodily <b>excretions</b>.</i>
<b>fertilizer</b>	Any substance such as manure or a mixture of nitrates used to make soil more fertile. <i>Sewage sludge could be a valuable <b>fertilizer</b> for use in British forests.</i>
<b>filth</b>	Corrupt behaviour; decadence. <i>You and all the others like you are <b>filth</b>.</i>
<b>forecastle</b>	A raised deck at the front of a ship.
<b>humus</b>	A thick spread made from mashed chickpeas, tahini, lemon juice and garlic; used especially as a dip for pita; originated in the Middle East.
<b>ingestion</b>	The process of absorbing information. <i>The effect of caffeine <b>ingestion</b> on exercise performance.</i>
<b>lavatory</b>	A room or building equipped with one or more toilets. <i>I needed to go to the <b>lavatory</b>.</i>
<b>manure</b>	Spread manure as for fertilization. <i>Artificial <b>manures</b>.</i>
<b>mulch</b>	Treat or cover with mulch. <i>The perennials have been cut back and <b>mulched</b>.</i>
<b>nutrient</b>	Any substance (such as a chemical element or inorganic compound) that can be taken in by a green plant and used in organic synthesis. <i>Fish is a source of many important <b>nutrients</b> including protein vitamins and minerals.</i>
<b>organic</b>	A food produced by organic farming. <i>The <b>organic</b> unity of the integral work of art.</i>



<b>peat</b>	A cut piece of peat. A <b>peat</b> bog.
<b>secretion</b>	A substance discharged by secretion. Hormonal <b>secretions</b> .
<b>sludge</b>	An unattractive muddy shade of brown or green. Miscellaneous chemicals and treated <b>sludges</b> .
<b>sweat</b>	Exude sweat. He was <b>sweating</b> profusely.
<b>toilet</b>	A room or building equipped with one or more toilets. Her <b>toilet</b> completed she finally went back downstairs.
<b>urinary</b>	Of or relating to the urinary system of the body. The <b>urinary</b> tract.
<b>waste</b>	Run off as waste. If the effort brings no compensating gain it is a <b>waste</b> .
