Infinitive	<b>to feel</b>
Present Tense	<b>feel / feels</b>
Past Tense	<b>felt</b>
Present Participle	<b>feeling</b>
Past Participle	<b>felt</b>

## Conjugate Feel

**Feel in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>feel</b>	We <b>feel</b>
You <b>feel</b>	You <b>feel</b>
He/She/It <b>feels</b>	They <b>feel</b>

### **Feel in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am feeling</b>	We <b>are feeling</b>
You <b>are feeling</b>	You <b>are feeling</b>
He/She/It <b>is feeling</b>	They <b>are feeling</b>

### **Feel in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have felt</b>	We <b>have felt</b>
You <b>have felt</b>	You <b>have felt</b>
He/She/It <b>has felt</b>	They <b>have felt</b>

### **Feel in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been feeling</b>	We <b>have been feeling</b>
You <b>have been feeling</b>	You <b>have been feeling</b>
He/She/It <b>has been feeling</b>	They <b>have been feeling</b>

### **Feel in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>felt</b>	We <b>felt</b>
You <b>felt</b>	You <b>felt</b>
He/She/It <b>felt</b>	They <b>felt</b>

### **Feel in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was feeling**                      We **were feeling**  
You **were feeling**                You **were feeling**  
He/She/It **was feeling**        They **were feeling**

**Feel in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had felt**                              We **had felt**  
You **had felt**                          You **had felt**  
He/She/It **had felt**                They **had felt**

**Feel in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been feeling**                We **had been feeling**  
You **had been feeling**            You **had been feeling**  
He/She/It **had been feeling**    They **had been feeling**

**Feel in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will feel**                              We **will feel**  
You **will feel**                          You **will feel**  
He/She/It **will feel**                They **will feel**

**Feel in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be feeling**                    We **will be feeling**  
You **will be feeling**                You **will be feeling**  
He/She/It **will be feeling**        They **will be feeling**

**I will have felt**

**We will have felt**

**You will have felt**

**You will have felt**

**He/She/It will have felt**

**They will have felt**

**Singular**

**I will have been feeling**

**We will have been feeling**

**You will have been feeling**

**You will have been feeling**

**He/She/It will have been feeling**

**They will have been feeling**
