Infinitive	<b>to ferry</b>
Present Tense	<b>ferry / ferries</b>
Past Tense	<b>ferried</b>
Present Participle	<b>ferrying</b>
Past Participle	<b>ferried</b>

## Conjugate Ferry

**Ferry in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>ferry</b>	We <b>ferry</b>
You <b>ferry</b>	You <b>ferry</b>
He/She/It <b>ferries</b>	They <b>ferry</b>

## **Ferry in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am ferrying</b>	We <b>are ferrying</b>
You <b>are ferrying</b>	You <b>are ferrying</b>
He/She/It <b>is ferrying</b>	They <b>are ferrying</b>

## **Ferry in Present Perfect Tense**

I <b>have ferried</b>	We <b>have ferried</b>
You <b>have ferried</b>	You <b>have ferried</b>
He/She/It <b>has ferried</b>	They <b>have ferried</b>

He/She/It <b>has been ferrying</b>	They <b>have been ferrying</b>

He/She/It <b>was ferrying</b>	They <b>were ferrying</b>

I <b>had ferried</b>	We <b>had ferried</b>
You <b>had ferried</b>	You <b>had ferried</b>
He/She/It <b>had ferried</b>	They <b>had ferried</b>

**Ferry in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>had been ferrying</b>	We <b>had been ferrying</b>
You <b>had been ferrying</b>	You <b>had been ferrying</b>
He/She/It <b>had been ferrying</b>	They <b>had been ferrying</b>

I <b>will ferry</b>	We <b>will ferry</b>
You <b>will ferry</b>	You <b>will ferry</b>
He/She/It <b>will ferry</b>	They <b>will ferry</b>

**Ferry in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I <b>will be ferrying</b>	We <b>will be ferrying</b>
You <b>will be ferrying</b>	You <b>will be ferrying</b>
He/She/It <b>will be ferrying</b>	They <b>will be ferrying</b>

**Ferry in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have ferried**

**We will have ferried**

**You will have ferried**

**You will have ferried**

**He/She/It will have ferried**

**They will have ferried**

**Ferry in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been ferrying**

**We will have been ferrying**

**You will have been ferrying**

**You will have been ferrying**

**He/She/It will have been ferrying**

**They will have been ferrying**
