acrid	Harsh or corrosive in tone. An acrid smell.
foetid	Offensively malodorous.
foul	Not hit between the foul lines. <i>Foul swampy water.</i>
foul-smelling	Offensively malodorous.
funky	Strongly musty. She likes funky clothes.
high	Literal meaning being at or having a relatively great or specific elevation or upward extension sometimes used in combinations like knee high. <i>High</i> summer.
ill-scented	Offensively malodorous.



malodorous	Having an unpleasant smell. Leaking taps and malodorous drains.
<u>nasty</u>	Damaging or harmful. A nasty accident.
noisome	Causing or able to cause nausea. <i>Noisome</i> vapours from the smouldering waste.
noxious	Harmful, poisonous, or very unpleasant. <i>Noxious</i> chemical wastes.
pungent	Strong and sharp. <i>Pungent</i> satire.
rank	Conspicuously and outrageously bad or reprehensible. <i>Rank treachery.</i>
reeking	Giving off a strong unpleasant smell. Wiped his reeking neck.
<u>smelly</u>	Having a strong or unpleasant smell. <i>Smelly feet.</i>
stinking	Very bad or unpleasant. He was locked in a stinking cell.
stinking to high heaven	Very bad.
<u>unpleasant</u>	Offensive or disagreeable; causing discomfort or unhappiness. <i>Unpleasant</i> odors.

baneful	Harmful or destructive. The baneful effects of envy and jealousy.
disgusting	Arousing revulsion or strong indignation. He had the most disgusting rotten teeth.
foul	Commit a foul break the rules. A foul pond.
loathsome	Causing hatred or disgust; repulsive. A loathsome disease.
lousy	Used to express anger, contempt, or annoyance. <i>Lousy weather</i> .
malodorous	Smelling very unpleasant. Leaking taps and malodorous drains.



musty	Covered with or smelling of mold. The musty formalities of the occasion.
nauseating	Causing or able to cause nausea. Some nauseating sentimental ditty.
nauseous	Feeling nausea; feeling about to vomit. This nauseous account of a court case.
noisome	Offensively malodorous. <i>Noisome</i> vapours from the smouldering waste.
noxious	Harmful, poisonous, or very unpleasant. <i>Noxious</i> chemical wastes.
<u>pernicious</u>	Having a harmful effect, especially in a gradual or subtle way. The pernicious influences of the mass media.
poisonous	(of a substance or plant) causing or capable of causing death or illness if taken into the body. <i>Poisonous</i> chemicals.
putrescent	Becoming putrid. The odour of putrescent flesh.
putrid	In an advanced state of decomposition and having a foul odor. A butcher who sold putrid meat.
queasy	Causing or fraught with or showing anxiety. The queasy swell of the boat.
rancid	(of foods containing fat or oil) smelling or tasting unpleasant as a result of being old and stale. <i>Rancid</i> butter.
repulsive	So extremely ugly as to be terrifying. A repulsive force.
<u>rotten</u>	Morally, socially, or politically corrupt. <i>He believed that the whole art business was rotten.</i>
<u>sickening</u>	Causing or liable to cause a feeling of nausea or disgust. She hit the ground with a sickening thud.
smell	Smell bad. Dogs locate the bait by smell .
<u>stale</u>	Make or become stale. Their marriage had gone stale .
stink	Smell badly and offensively. The stink of the place hit me as I went in.



stinking	Extremely. It s a stinking world.
unclean	(in biblical use) ritually impure; (of a spirit) evil. Unclean thoughts.
<u>unhealthy</u>	(of a person's attitude or behaviour) not sensible or well balanced. <i>His skin looked pale and unhealthy.</i>
unwholesome	Detrimental to physical or moral well-being. Unwholesome food.
venomous	(of a person or their behaviour) full of malice or spite. <i>The box jellyfish is earth s most venomous creature.</i>
vile	Morally reprehensible. The vile development of slavery appalled them.
