## Associations of "Few" (30 Words)

<b>about</b>	Slightly short of or not quite accomplished; all but. <i>Wandering <b>about</b> with no place to go.</i>
<a href="#"><u>almost</u></a>	(of actions or states) slightly short of or not quite accomplished; all but. <i>Blues jazz he can play <b>almost</b> anything.</i>
<b>approximately</b>	Imprecise but fairly close to correct. <i>Lasted <b>approximately</b> an hour.</i>
<b>around</b>	All around or on all sides. <i>Weighs <b>around</b> a hundred pounds.</i>
<b>equidistant</b>	The same distance apart at every point. <i>The line joins together all points which are <b>equidistant</b> from the two axes.</i>
<a href="#"><u>half</u></a>	To the extent of half. <i><b>Half</b> a loaf.</i>
<a href="#"><u>handful</u></a>	The quantity that can be held in the hand. <i>A small <b>handful</b> of fresh coriander.</i>
<b>iota</b>	The ninth star in a constellation. <i>Nothing she said seemed to make an <b>iota</b> of difference.</i>
<b>least</b>	Used in names of very small animals and plants e g least shrew. <i>He has the <b>least</b> talent of anyone.</i>
<a href="#"><u>less</u></a>	Used to form the comparative of some adjectives and adverbs. <i>Of <b>less</b> importance.</i>
<b>little</b>	Informal small and of little importance. <i>Gave it <b>little</b> thought.</i>
<a href="#"><u>marginal</u></a>	Relating to water adjacent to the land's edge or coast. <i>Water lilies and <b>marginal</b> aquatics.</i>
<b>mini</b>	Denoting a miniature version of something. <i>A <b>mini</b> dress.</i>

<b><u>minimal</u></b>	(of a pair of forms) distinguished by only one feature. <i>Production costs are <b>minimal</b>.</i>
<b><u>minimum</u></b>	The smallest possible quantity. <i><b>Minimum</b> wage.</i>
<b><u>nearly</u></b>	Very close to; almost. <i>In the absence of anyone more <b>nearly</b> related I was designated next of kin.</i>
<b><u>negligible</u></b>	Not worth considering. <i>He said that the risks were <b>negligible</b>.</i>
<b><u>partially</u></b>	In part; in some degree; not wholly. <i>The work <b>partially</b> fulfills the function of a historical memoir.</i>
<b><u>practically</u></b>	Almost; nearly. <i>The place was <b>practically</b> empty.</i>
<b>rarefaction</b>	Reduction in the density of something, especially air or a gas. <i>A series of <b>rarefactions</b> and compactions.</i>
<b><u>rather</u></b>	More readily or willingly. <i>He s <b>rather</b> an unpleasant man.</i>
<b><u>roughly</u></b>	With roughness or violence rough is an informal variant for roughly. <i>People were crouching over <b>roughly</b> built brick fireplaces.</i>
<b><u>several</u></b>	Of an indefinite number more than 2 or 3 but not many. <i><b>Several</b> letters came in the mail.</i>
<b>slight</b>	An insult caused by a failure to show someone proper respect or attention. <i>A Council determined whether the Fort should be kept or <b>slighted</b>.</i>
<b><u>slightly</u></b>	(with reference to a person's build) in a slender way. <i>They are all <b>slightly</b> different.</i>
<b>smattering</b>	A small amount of something. <i>A <b>smattering</b> of snow.</i>
<b><u>some</u></b>	To some extent quite a lot. <i>They were here for <b>some</b> weeks.</i>
<b>soupcon</b>	A slight but appreciable amount.
<b>trifle</b>	A small amount of something. <i>We will not <b>trifle</b> life is too short.</i>
<b>wee</b>	Very small. <i>When I was just a <b>wee</b> bairn.</i>
