Associations of "Few" (30 Words)

about	Slightly short of or not quite accomplished; all but. <i>Wandering about with no place to go.</i>
<u>almost</u>	(of actions or states) slightly short of or not quite accomplished; all but. <i>Blues jazz he can play almost anything.</i>
approximately	Imprecise but fairly close to correct. <i>Lasted approximately an hour.</i>
around	All around or on all sides. <i>Weighs around a hundred pounds.</i>
equidistant	The same distance apart at every point. <i>The line joins together all points which are equidistant from the two axes.</i>
<u>half</u>	To the extent of half. <i>Half a loaf.</i>
<u>handful</u>	The quantity that can be held in the hand. <i>A small handful of fresh coriander.</i>
iota	The ninth star in a constellation. <i>Nothing she said seemed to make an iota of difference.</i>
least	Used in names of very small animals and plants e.g. least shrew. <i>He has the least talent of anyone.</i>
<u>less</u>	Used to form the comparative of some adjectives and adverbs. <i>Of less importance.</i>
little	Informal small and of little importance. <i>Gave it little thought.</i>
<u>marginal</u>	Relating to water adjacent to the land's edge or coast. <i>Water lilies and marginal aquatics.</i>
mini	Denoting a miniature version of something. <i>A mini dress.</i>

<u>minimal</u>	(of a pair of forms) distinguished by only one feature. <i>Production costs are minimal.</i>
<u>minimum</u>	The smallest possible quantity. <i>Minimum wage.</i>
<u>nearly</u>	Very close to; almost. <i>In the absence of anyone more nearly related I was designated next of kin.</i>
<u>negligible</u>	Not worth considering. <i>He said that the risks were negligible.</i>
<u>partially</u>	In part; in some degree; not wholly. <i>The work partially fulfills the function of a historical memoir.</i>
<u>practically</u>	Almost; nearly. <i>The place was practically empty.</i>
rarefaction	Reduction in the density of something, especially air or a gas. <i>A series of rarefactions and compactions.</i>
<u>rather</u>	More readily or willingly. <i>He s rather an unpleasant man.</i>
<u>roughly</u>	With roughness or violence rough is an informal variant for roughly. <i>People were crouching over roughly built brick fireplaces.</i>
<u>several</u>	Of an indefinite number more than 2 or 3 but not many. <i>Several letters came in the mail.</i>
slight	An insult caused by a failure to show someone proper respect or attention. <i>A Council determined whether the Fort should be kept or slighted.</i>
<u>slightly</u>	(with reference to a person's build) in a slender way. <i>They are all slightly different.</i>
smattering	A small amount of something. <i>A smattering of snow.</i>
<u>some</u>	To some extent quite a lot. <i>They were here for some weeks.</i>
soupcon	A slight but appreciable amount.
trifle	A small amount of something. <i>We will not trifle life is too short.</i>
wee	Very small. <i>When I was just a wee bairn.</i>
