Fictional as an Adjective

Definitions of "Fictional" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “fictional” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Formed or conceived by the imagination.*
- *Related to or involving literary fiction.*
- *Relating to or occurring in fiction; invented for the purposes of fiction.*



Synonyms of "Fictional" as an adjective (8 Words)

- fabricated** Formed or conceived by the imagination.
*A **fabricated** excuse for his absence.*
- fancied** Formed or conceived by the imagination.
*A **fancied** wrong.*
- fictitious** Adopted in order to deceive.
*A **fictitious** address.*
- imaginary** Not based on fact; existing only in the imagination.
*Chris had **imaginary** conversations with her.*
- imagined** (of something unreal or untrue) believed to exist or be so.
*They perceive **imagined** slights where none exist.*
- make-believe** Imagined as in a play.
- mythical** Fictitious.
*One of Denmark's greatest **mythical** heroes.*
- unreal** Lacking material form or substance unreal.
*Ghosts and other **unreal** entities.*



Usage Examples of "Fictional" as an adjective

- *Fictional texts.*
- *A fictional character.*
